



BYU German Fair



Each year Timpview students represent the school and compete at the BYU German Fair in April. Timpview has a strong tradition of excellent performances at the Fair. The German Fair is one of the crowning events of the school year.

Participation:

Because of restrictions from BYU, only the best 5-7 students from each class participate in the German Fair. The best students are chosen based on their performance in class.

Competitions:

Students may compete in a variety of competitions: conversation, show and tell, poetry, skits, scene from a play, music, prepared speech, oral interview, culture bowl. The students perform for judges who rate them Superior, Excellent, Very Good, and Good.

Best of Fair Awards:

Each judge chooses the best performance from among the students he/ she judged. Those students are awarded the “Best of Fair.” This is a prestigious award. Each year, many Timpview students are honored with this award.

Klein Deutschland:

Between competitions, students may visit Kleindeutschland and participate in a variety of cultural experiences. Each school that comes to the fair sponsors a booth in Kleindeutschland. Timpview students not competing in the events may come to the BYU Fair and work in the Kleindeutschland booth.
