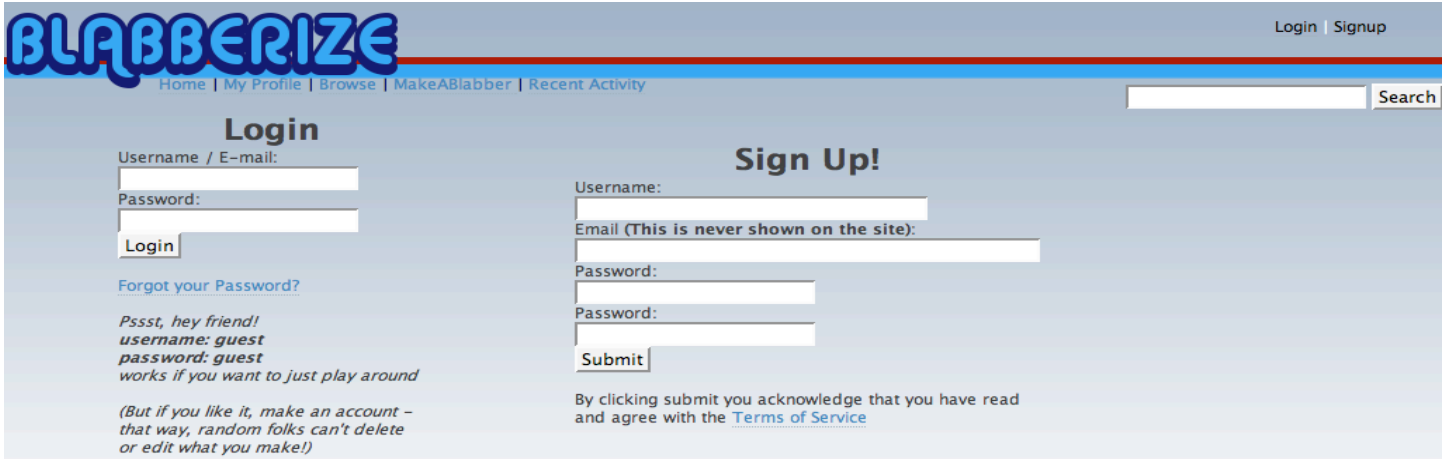
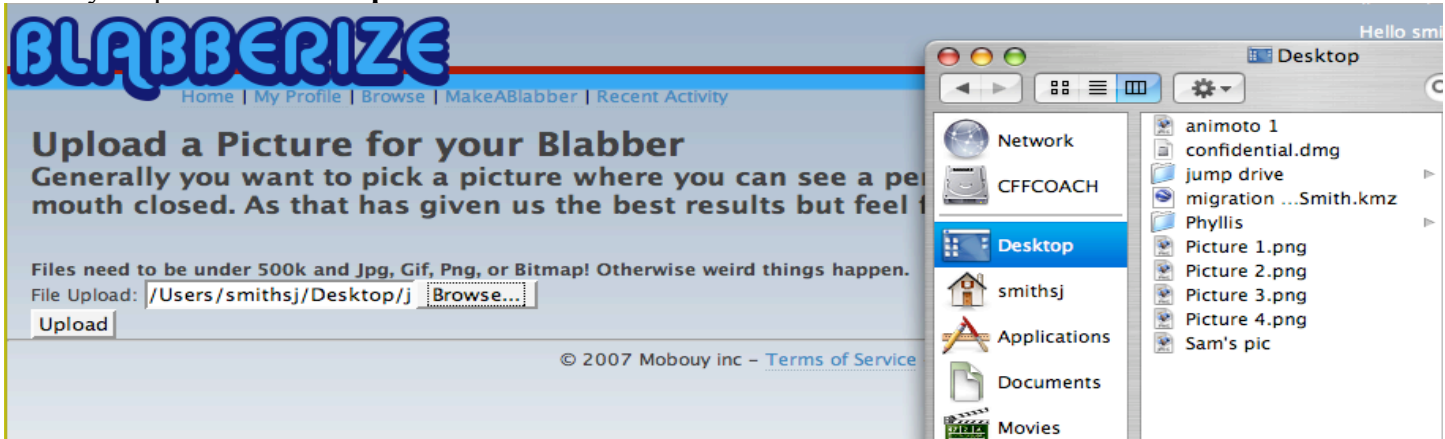




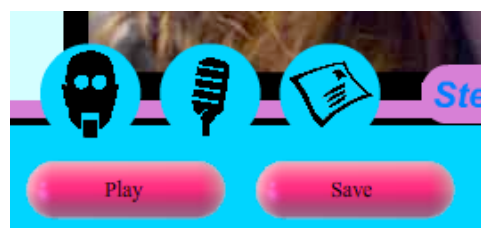
1. Before you sign up or log in you need to find a picture that you want to use for your Blabber and have a script written out that you want to say. Be sure to save the picture to your desktop in a jpeg format.
2. Go to Blabberize.com



3. **Sign Up!** Enter your username: using **rllastnamefirstname** email: **rllastnamefirstname@gaggle.net** When you choose a password make sure it's something you will remember. If you forget your password or username, you will have to email Blabberize directly to reset them. Choose Submit.
4. The page will refresh and look just like it does above. Now you will need to **Login** with the username and password you just created.
5. Choose **MakeABlabber** just below the main logo above. The following screen will appear. Now you need to Upload a picture from your desktop. Choose **Browse** and find your picture on your computer. Once you found your picture choose **Upload**.

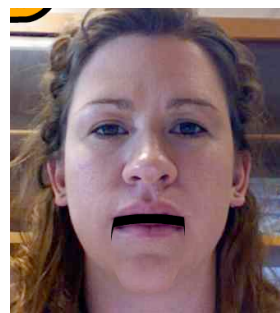
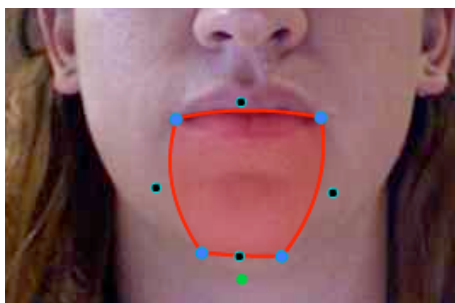
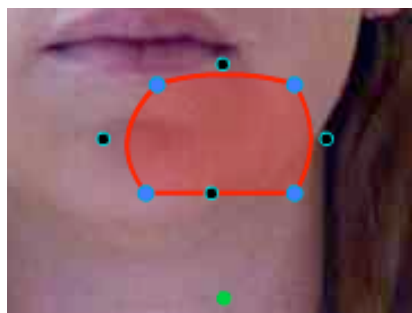


6. You will see your picture appear on the screen and the following text box. Choose **ALLOW**. This will enable your microphone.

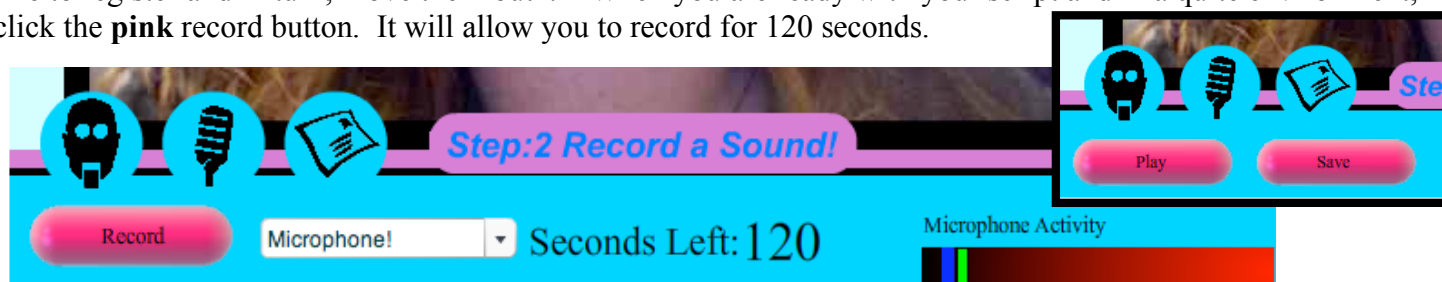


These are the controls within Blabberize. The head is for the mouth placement, the microphone is for recording and the letter is for sharing.

7. You need move the red shape to the bottom half of the mouth. The blue dots depict the corners of the mouth while the black dots change the shape of the mouth. The single green dot indicates the pathway the mouth will move in and the distance the mouth will move when a sound registers. Now click the microphone below.



8. Now you are ready to record. Make sure your script is ready. The microphone on a Macbook is located next to the camera so it's on the top of your laptop screen on the left just off the center. You need to bring your laptop close to you so it will register your voice as you see below. The green line needs to slide past the blue line to register and in turn, move the mouth. When you are ready with your script and in a quite environment, click the **pink** record button. It will allow you to record for 120 seconds.



9. Now you need to click on the letter/envelope to play your recording and decide if you're ready to save (click the save button) or if you want to record again (click on the microphone and repeat #8 on). If you choose save your recording the following screen will come up. Make sure to fill in each section or Blabberize will not allow you to go any further. Check with your teacher to find out how to name the blabber and how to tag it to make it easier to search for. You will only need to make it private if it's a picture of you with any of your information in the recording (name, where you live, etc... to protect your identity). Once you choose Save, your blabber will pop up with a play button as you see below.

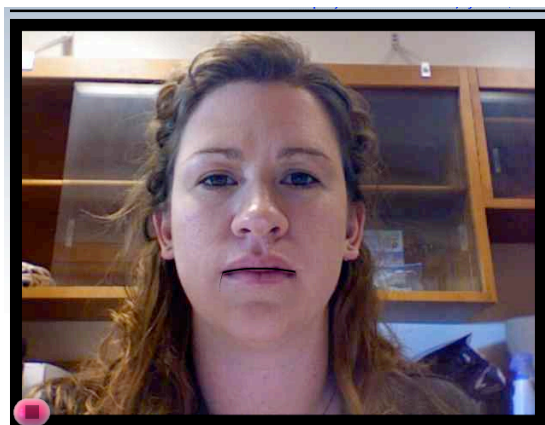
