

Rounding to the nearest hundredth

Purpose:

The purpose of this activity is to help your child to learn to round to the nearest hundredth.

Link to the Number Framework:

Place value, Stage 8

What you need:

Tape measure or ruler

Pen and paper

What to do:

Work with your child to make a list of objects they could measure around the house.

Explain you will measure things in metres and round it to the nearest centimetre.

Check your child understands there are 100 centimetres in a metre.

Measure the objects and record the measurement to the nearest centimetre. For example 1.35m.

What to expect your child to do:

- To round numbers to the nearest hundredth (centimetre).
