

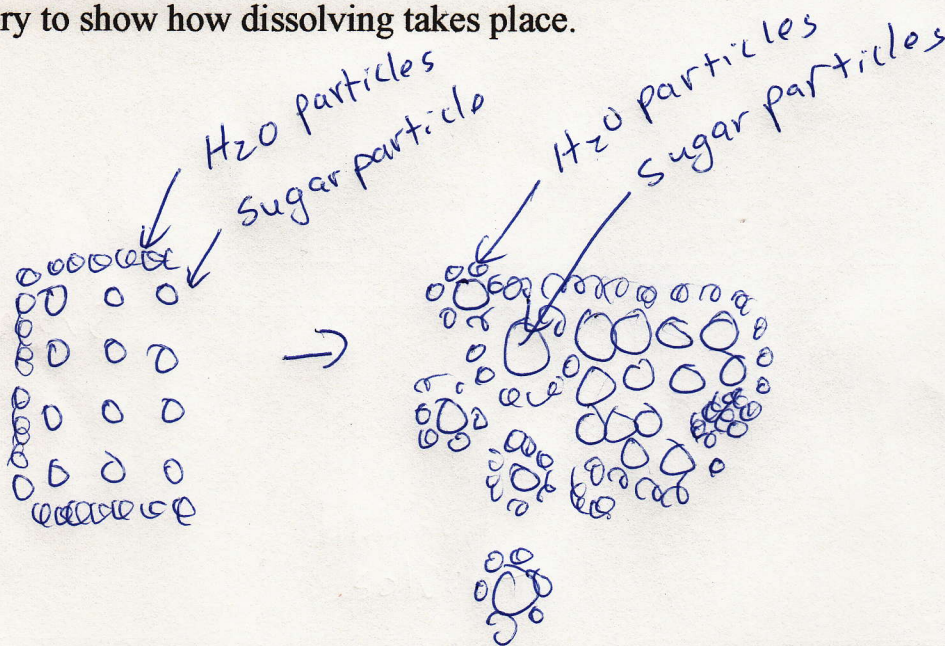

On the other hand, the material that is dissolved in the solvent is called the solute. In a sugar solution, the sugar is the solute. Because sugar dissolves in water, we say that sugar is soluble in water. If a material can not be dissolved, we say that it is insoluble. Fat in milk is insoluble.
