Am I A Bully?

- Do I pick on or make fun of other students, steal belongings, or threaten to hurt others?
- Do I believe it is OK to bully others just because they are different?
- Am I "acting out" because I was once bullied?
- Do I understand that my actions have a negative effect on other students and the bus ride to and from school?
- Do I understand my actions could get me into trouble, including suspension from school or being arrested?

What is Bullying?

- Extreme teasing
- Name-calling
- Stealing lunches, personal belongings
- Older students picking on younger students
- Making fun of students with disabilities
- Making fun of students who are different
- Tripping or slapping other students on the bus
- Threatening to hurt someone
- Showing a weapon on the bus

What Should I Do If I Am Bullied?

I WON'T BE SILENT! I will talk to my driver, a teacher, parent or someone I trust about the situation. That person will talk to the appropriate person at school to decide what to do to help end the bullying.

I WILL NOT BULLY BACK! I will let the adults take care of the problem, and not add to the problem by fighting back in words or actions.
