

# Play safe board game

## Aim:

To encourage the children to think about safe clothing to wear and safe places to play when on skateboards, roller blades, scooters and bicycles.

## Activity:

### Play Safe Board Game

- Work with the children to make a board game where the children write either hazards or safety measures and their consequences on squares of the board.
- Help the children to make up hazards or safety measures for skateboarding, roller blading, scootering or cycling.
- The children can either make their own board and counters for the game or use Worksheets 1 and 2 as a guideline to work from.

## Suggested Timing:

1-1½ hours

## Resources:

- Worksheets 1 and 2
- Card
- Scissors
- Pencils, pens, crayons, rubbers, rulers etc
- Dice
- If making own board - glue and spreaders, thick card

## Extension:

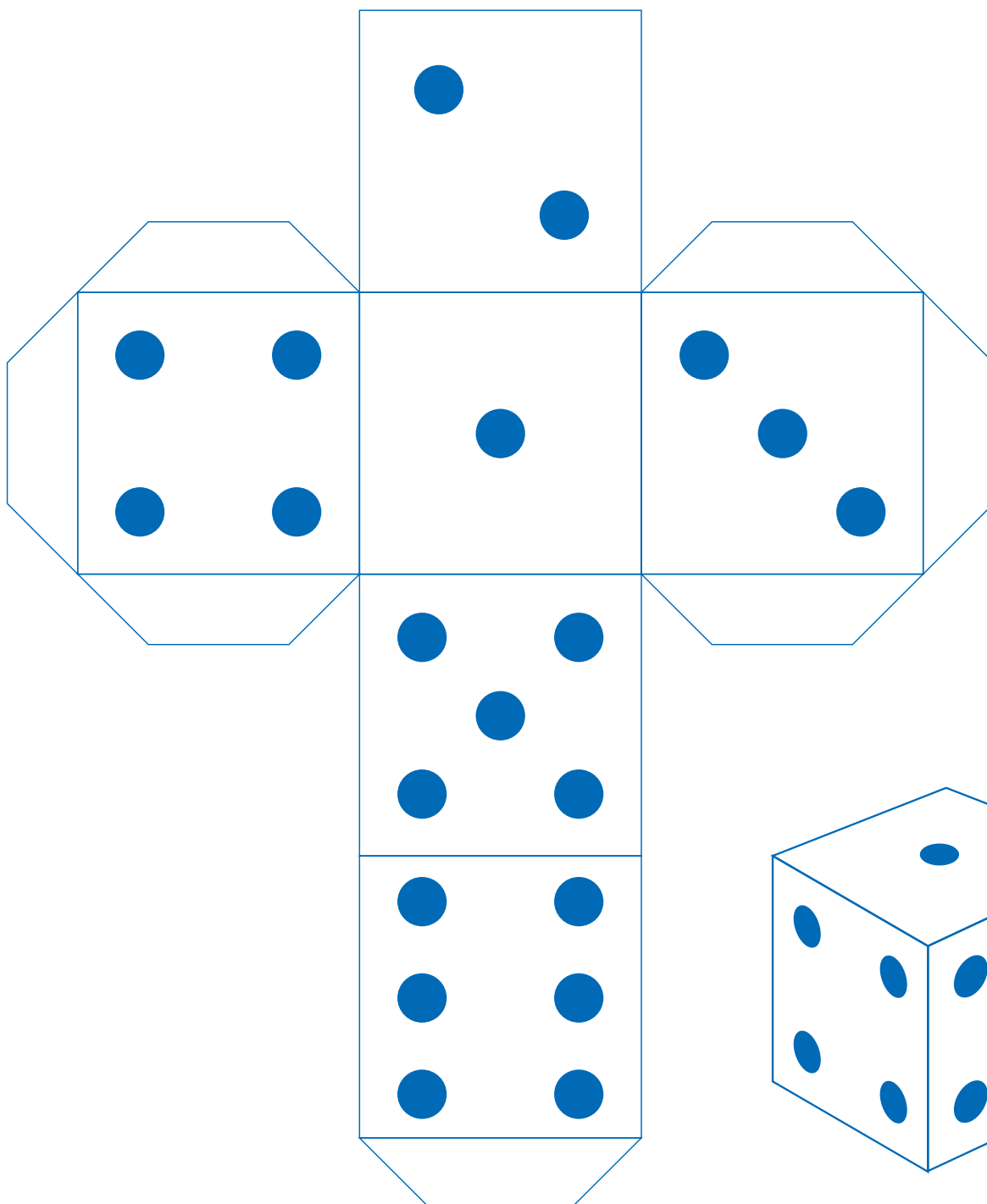
### Competition

Design a fashionable and safe outfit for skateboarding, roller blading, scootering or cycling. Explain to the children that the outfit must be bright, have protective pads and include a helmet. They should give reasons for their design.

## Background Information:

Maintenance		Safety	Ways of Minimising Hazards
Skateboards, Scooters, Micro-scooters	Ensure wheels are clean and properly fitted.	Helmet Elbow and knee pads Bright or reflective clothing	Use away from the road e.g. park, skate park, garden Don't annoy or get in other people's way
Bicycles	Check tyres and brakes are in good working order, chain is oiled and handlebars and seat are at correct height. Make sure that you have reflectors and lights fitted if the bike will be used in poor visibility.	Helmet Bright or reflective clothing	Learn the Highway Code Complete a cycle training scheme Obey road signs Where possible use cycle paths, cycle lanes, the park
Roller blades	Check wheels and stops are clean and properly fitted. Make sure that boots are correct size and support ankles.	Helmet Elbow and knee pads Bright or reflective clothing	Use away from the road e.g. park, skate park, garden Don't annoy or get in other people's way
