Answer both of the questions in a paragraph each.

1. Based on “Popo and Ixtla,” what can you conclude about the place of women in Aztec society? Explain in a paragraph and use at least two examples from the reading.
2. An epic is a story or long poem about the adventures of a larger-than-life hero. An epic may be distinguished by these traditional characteristics:
 - It involves a dangerous journey, or quest.
 - The hero receives help from gods or powerful characters.
 - The events unfold in at least several nations.
 - The story is told in a serious, formal style.

In an essay, discuss those characteristics in terms of “Perseus.” How is it epic? Explain with at least two examples.
