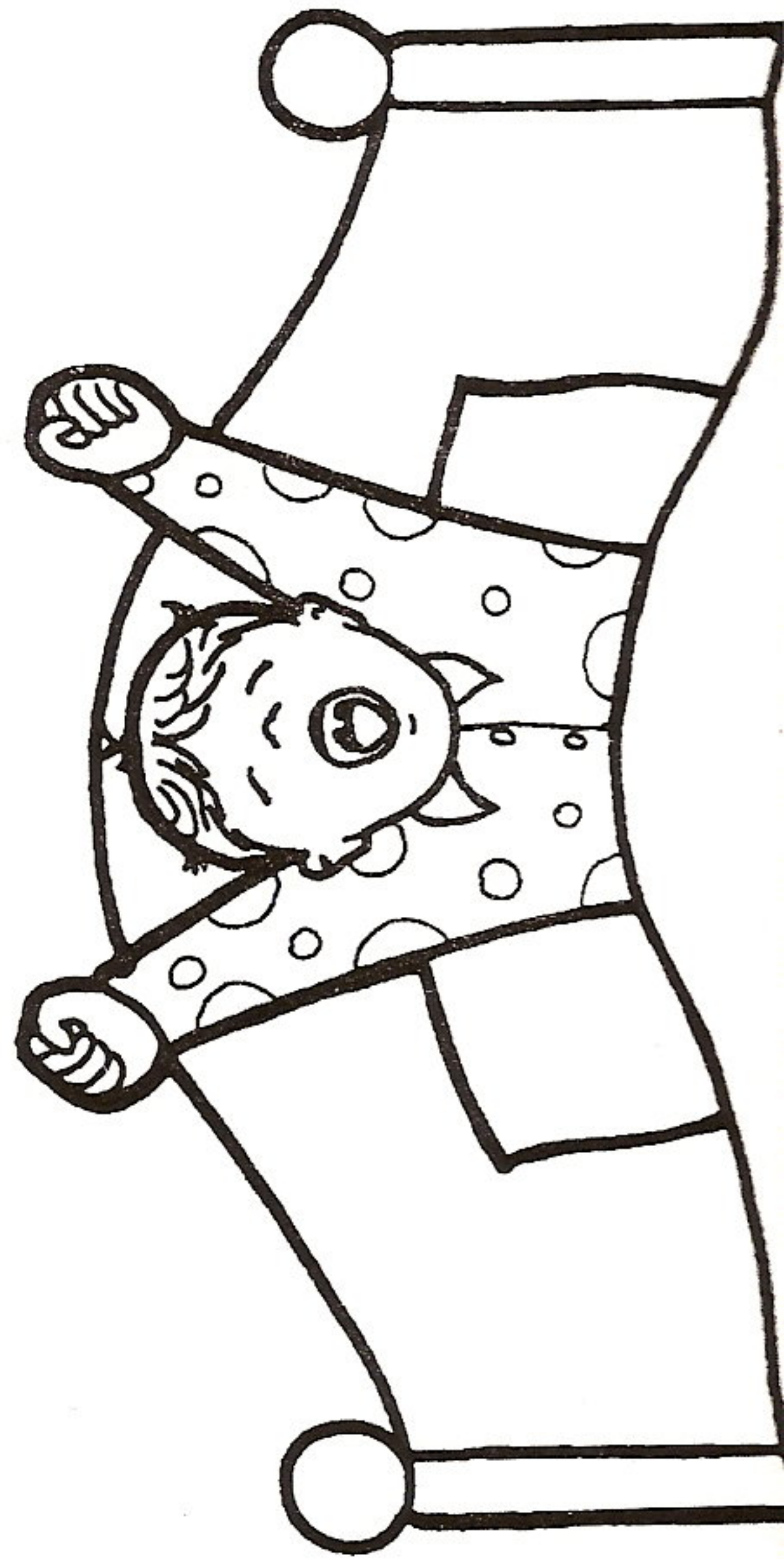
Activity
