


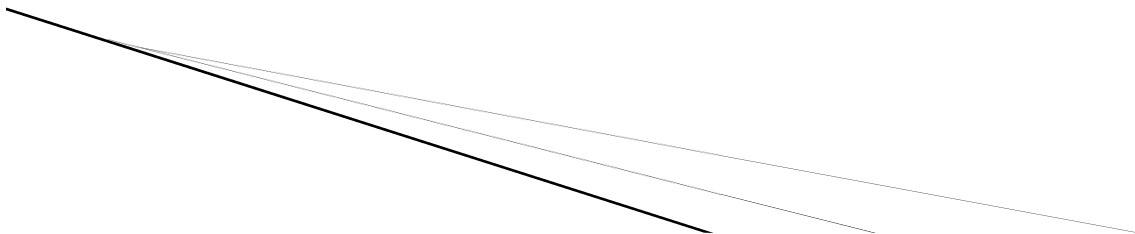



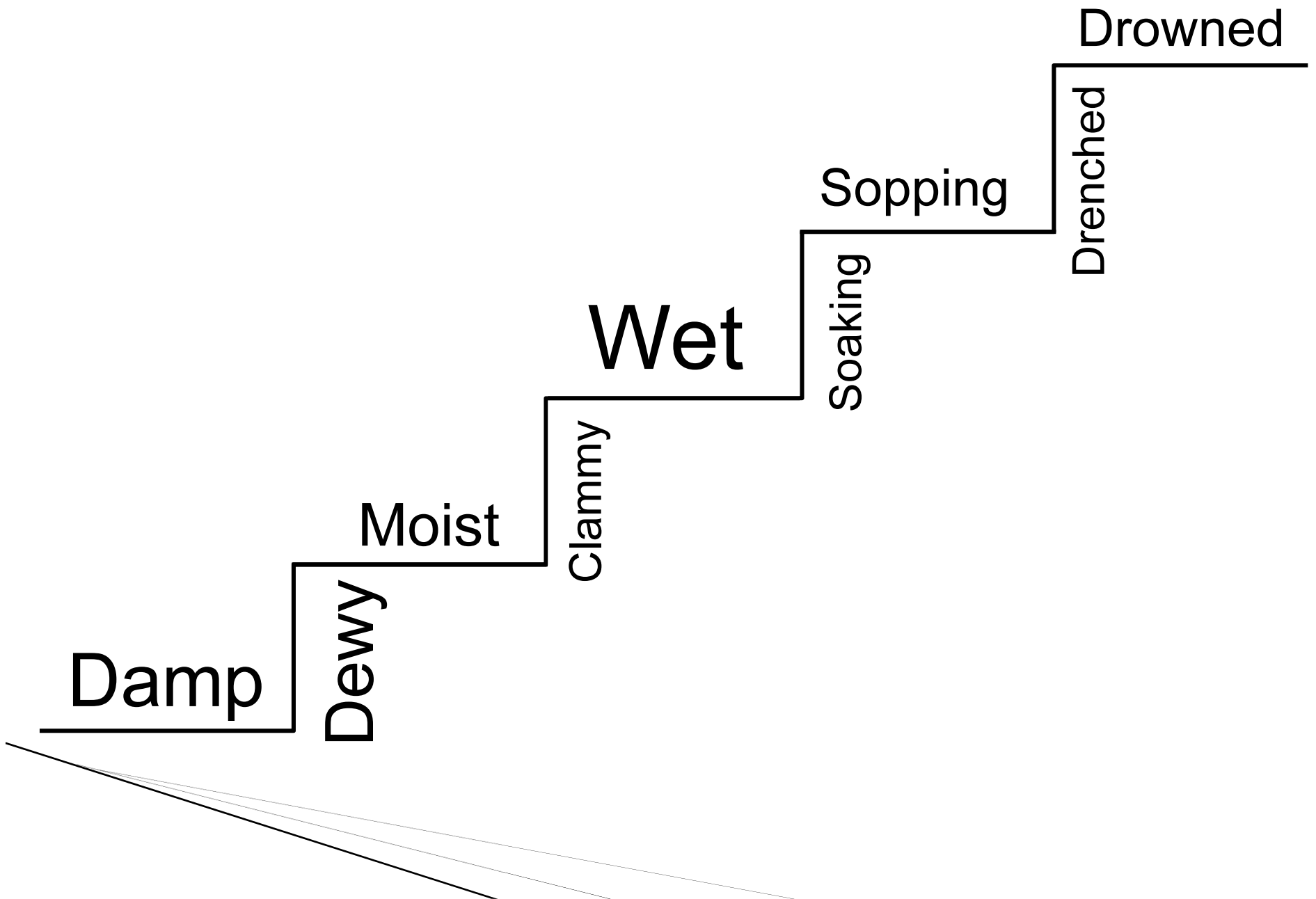
Tools to help with Word Choice:
