21) Apostrophes 2

In your notes, copy the following rule and examples for using commas:

Apostrophes are used to show when a noun possesses something.

If you need to show that a noun possesses something, put an apostrophe at the end. If there is **NO S**, add one **AFTER** the apostrophe.

Example: Dog's, Nancy's, Stue's, Youngker's

If there is an s, **DON'T** add another.

Example: Gladys', rocks', students', stores'
