Fallacies



- Stating only two choices when more are available.

Either/Or



- Reaching a conclusion about a topic without enough evidence.

- When the argument is only supported by itself, and not any actual facts or evidence.

Circular Reasoning



- To make a comparison as an argument that is illogical or doesn't make sense.

False Analogy



- Making an incorrect assumption between cause and effect.
