A form of poetry without any rhyme scheme written in seven stanzas.

Stanzas

□ 1-6:

- ▣ Six lines each
- ▣ The end words are reused and repeated in a certain pattern in each of the stanzas.

□ 7:

- ▣ Three lines
- ▣ The same six words are repeated, this time two words in each line. The poet chooses in what order the words appear.
