

Student/Teacher Contract: Miss Romito's Class

The following are the expected rules of behavior for Miss Romito's classroom as well as the disciplinary procedures. **Each student and a parent or guardian must read over this contract and then sign it to show that both understand what is expected of each student while he/she is in Miss Romito's classroom.** The students have also gone over these rules with Miss Romito on the first day of school, and should have no excuse not to be aware of what is expected of each of them.

Classroom Policies:

1. Respect for teacher and students. This means no talking when Miss Romito or another student is talking. No insulting language or behaviors towards Miss Romito or other students. Miss Romito will respect you if you respect her.
2. In seat, prepared and working on bell ringer by the time the bell rings. Being out of the seat when the bell rings counts as a tardy and the student WILL BE sent to SWEEP, regardless of if they are already in the classroom. A one minute warning bell sounds before the start of each class period. This is the students warning to get in their seats so they don't end up in sweep.
3. Work during class time. This is not a social hour.
4. No food or drink in the classroom, except for water bottles (must be in bottles).
5. No swearing.
6. Bags and purses stay under the desks. NOT on laps, NOT on desks, NOT on seats behind you.
7. Electronics can only be used per Miss Romito's direction. Any electronics being used outside of the times set by Miss Romito will be confiscated and handled according to student hand book policy.
 - a. There is still no texting in class. Any student found texting in class period will be handled according to the guidelines of the student handbook.
 - b. Devices are the responsibility of the student they belong to. Ms. Romito cannot be held responsible for any device that is broken or stolen.
8. Follow the dress code as outlined by the student handbook.
9. Miss Romito will follow all rules regarding: dress code, electronics, gum, food, etc. in accordance with Youngker High School policy. If it's against the school rules, then it is against Miss Romito's classroom rules.

Disciplinary Actions:

1. Warning – Verbal or non-verbal redirect. A kindly reminder that Miss Romito's class time is not social time or play time. There is work to do and that is what the student should be focused on. The student gets only **one**.

2. Individual Conference – If the behavior continues after the initial warning, then the student and Miss Romito will have a one on one talk after class. The student will also be required to fill out a student reflection form.
3. Detentions and parent involvements – If the behavior still does not stop, Miss Romito will employ ANY of the following consequences AND a call home to parents.
 - Seat Change
 - After School Detention
 - 1st time: 15 minutes
 - 2nd time: 30 minutes
 - Removal from Classroom
4. Lunch Detention – If none of the previous attempts to help a student change their classroom behavior are successful, the student will be issued a lunch detention to be served with security.
5. Referral – After all previous misbehavior steps have been exhausted, the student will automatically receive referrals for infractions. Referrals will result in loss of points for the student.
 - Failure to comply with the consequences of misbehavior will result in an automatic referral.
