A poem written in 7 lines and shaped like a diamond. Each line has a specific type of word to use. Diamantes are written about two opposite ideas.

Word Scheme

- Line 1: 1 word - Noun (opposite of Line 7)
- Line 2: 2 words - Adjectives (Describe Line 1)
- Line 3: 3 words - ending in "-ing" (Describe Line 1)
- Line 4: 4 words - Nouns (the first two go with the noun in line 1, the second two go with the noun in line 7)
- Line 5: 3 words - ending in "-ing" (Describe line 7)
- Line 6: 2 words - Adjectives (Describe line 7)
- Line 7: 1 word - Noun (opposite of Line 1)
