 - e. For each individual citation, put a period and a space for every piece of info.
 - f. Format Dates: day month year
 - i. Days are given numerically (4, 13, 26)
 - ii. Month is first three letters of the month and a period (Jun. Nov.)
 - iii. Year is written in full (2012)
