

Poison 18

The winner of the game is the person (or team) who gains the most points.

Each team takes it in turns to place one of their digits on the board.

The object of the game is to score the maximum number of points when all the digits are on the board.

How do you score points: Points are scored by totaling the numbers in a row (for team A) or a column (for team B) The number of points you score is the difference between the total and 18.

For example: If a row totals 16 or 20 then team A scores 2 points. If a column totals 18 then the score for that column is 0.

Each team finds the total of their 4 rows or columns.

Strategy: Place numbers to maximize your score and minimize your opponents score.
