Reading Street

Unit 1 Week 5

Big Question: How are people and animals Important to one another?

Weekly Focus Question: Which wild animals live in our neighborhood?

Story: *Get the Egg!*

Amazing (vocabulary) Words: croak, moist, hatch, survive, habitat, chirp

Phonics Skill: short e, initial consonant blends

Comprehension Skill: Main Idea Details
