**Phonics Skill:** Letter names/sounds: r, w, k, j, short e

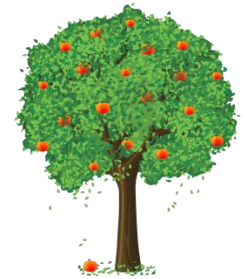
**Comprehension Skill:** Plot
