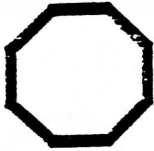

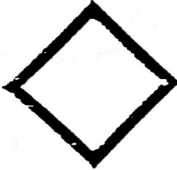
Hazardous Household Product Symbols
