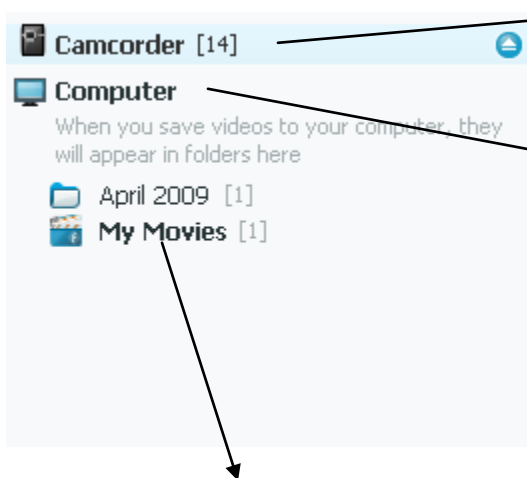
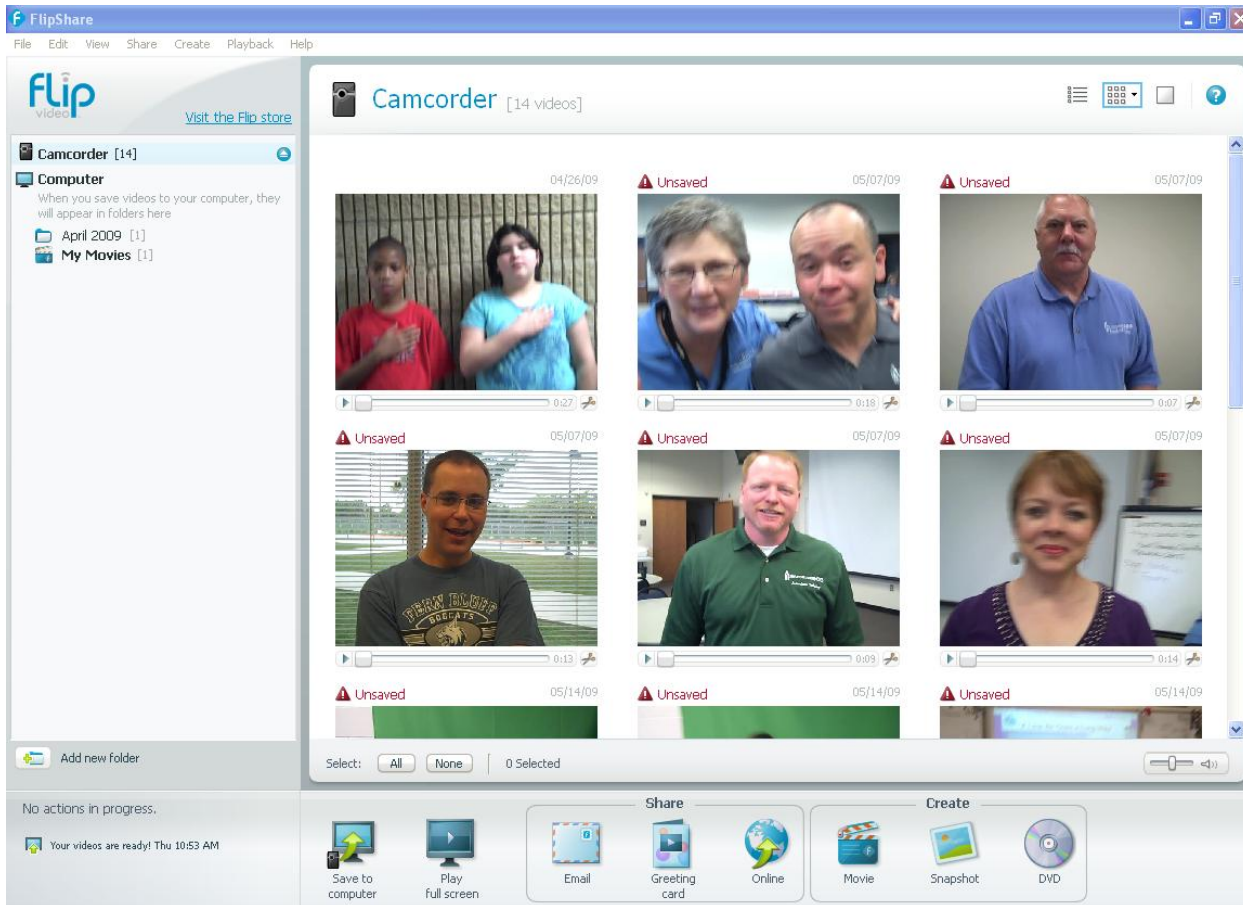


Making Sense of Flip Share



Videos on camcorder

Videos saved to your computer. Organized in FlipShare into folders based on the month you recorded the video, but the actual location on your computer is My Documents> My Videos> Flip Share Data > Videos. You also can create folders and name them as you like.

My Movies: when you create a movie (clips added together as one continuous file) they are saved in this folder.

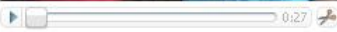

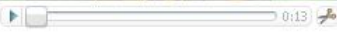

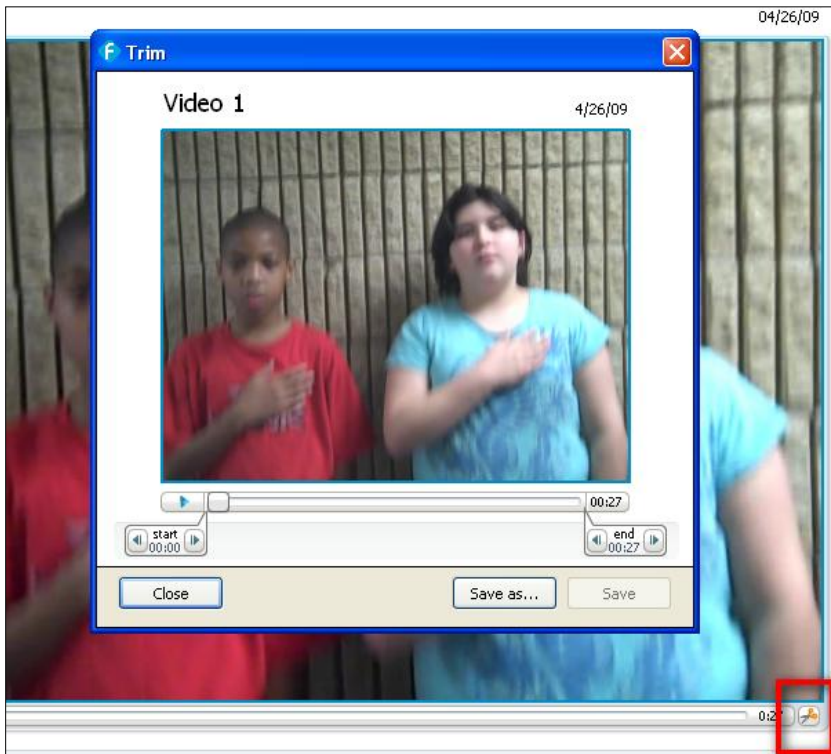


Thumbnail format: lets you see the videos in a small player. You can click the play button to watch a preview.



Show one video in large format.

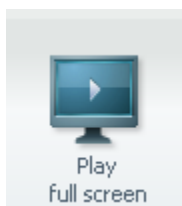
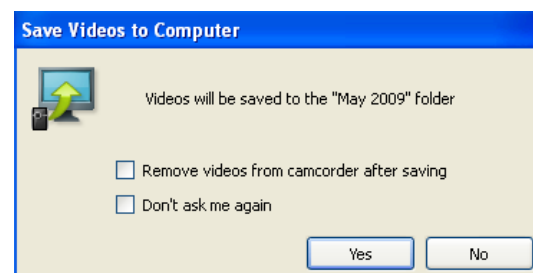
Trimming a video:



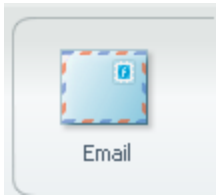
Clicking the scissors icon will let you trim a video by choosing a specific start and end time. If you choose SAVE AS... this creates a copy of the video and leave the original intact. If you want to trim a piece in the middle out, you will have to do this twice, creating a clip before the part you want to edit out, and a clip after. Choosing SAVE will REPLACE the video.



Choose Save To Computer. It will save to FlipShare in folder organized by month. You can remove the video from the camera as well.



Play full screen: the video will take up the whole screen. Press ESC to exit Full Screen Mode.

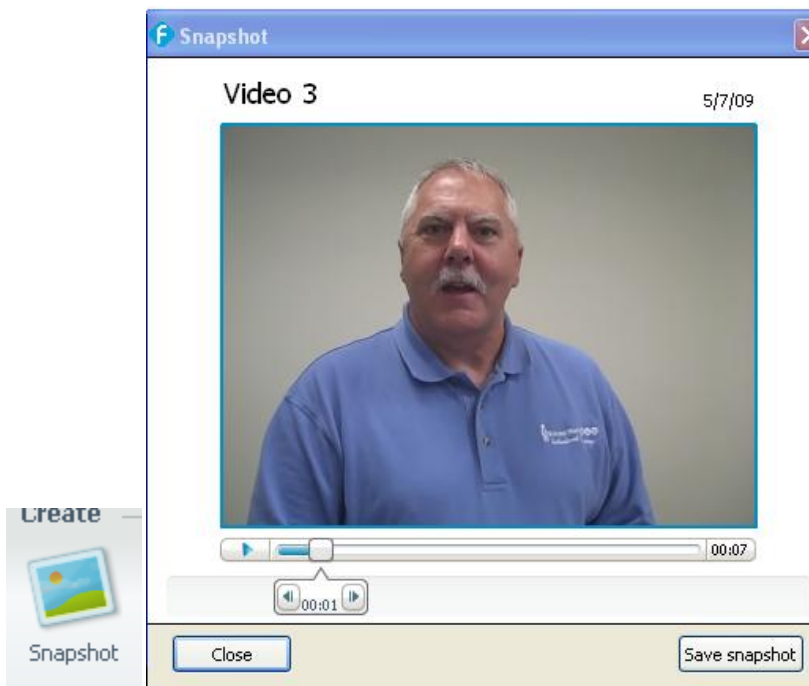
Choosing Online lets you upload /gets your videos ready to upload. If you choose AOL Video, MySpace, or YouTube you will be prompted to log in to your account (or create one) and it will walk you through uploading your video. If you choose Other Web Sites, it will convert your video to a .wmv (a file that is smaller in memory) and places it in a folder on your desktop.



Creating a Movie lets you put several clips together in one continuous file. Select the clips you want, drag them to the order you want them in. You have the option to put in titles and credits.

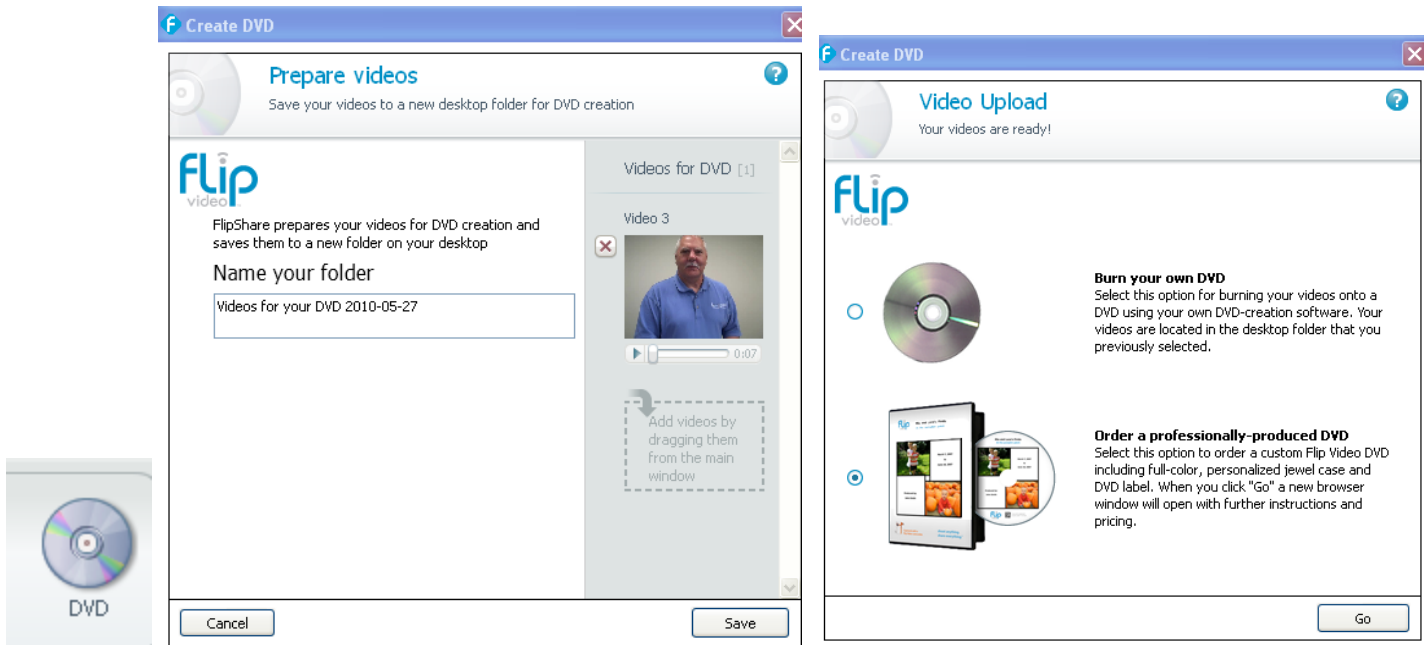


You can add music to your movie if you want and even take out the sound from the video you captured. You'll be asked to name your movie, then it will be created and saved in you're my Movies folder.



Get your video to the place where you want to take a snapshot. You can play & pause or drag the slider over. Choose save snapshot and you will be prompted to choose a place to save your image.





If you choose to create a DVD, you'll drag and drop the videos you want and choose save. You've be given the option to burn your own, or order a professionally produced video. If you choose to burn your own, it will convert your videos to .wmv format and place them in a folder on your desktop. You'll use your own DVD disc and whatever software you prefer (such as Roxio creator) to burn the files to DVD.
