

Students expectations:

- Be courteous, polite, supportive, and respectful to both classmates and teacher.
- Arrive to class on time and with proper materials -- books, writing utensil, and homework.
- Check class website for homework each night.
- Give their best effort on all their work for the class.
- Be an attentive and active participant in class.
- Focus on using the French language in class.
- Ask for extra help or challenge on a regular basis.

Biweekly grades will consist of 100 points from the following categories:

- Ten days of 4 pt class participation - a possibility of receiving 40 points during the biweekly
 - 4 points for speaking above instruction level - expanding vocabulary and structures from the lesson.
 - 3 points for speaking at instruction level - use adequate vocabulary and grammar.
 - 2 points for speaking below instruction level - frequently incorrect use of vocabulary and grammar.
 - 1 point for speaking far-below instruction level - errors predominately in use of vocabulary and grammar.
- Four 5 pt graded homework assignments - a possibility of receiving 20 points per biweekly
 - Points will be deducted for misspellings, improper grammar and/or vocabulary, and repeated accent mistakes.
- Two 20 pt graded assessments - a possibility of receiving 40 points per biweekly
 - There maybe any combination of two smaller or one larger assessment -- using oral, written, and listening aspects of the curriculum.

Effort grades:

- A “plus” will be earned when the student shows extended effort to go beyond the student expectations to learn French.
- A “minus” will be earned when the students does not meet the student expectations mentioned.
