

## Creating a Basic Blog

### 1. Open iWeb



\* Click the iWeb icon or use Spotlight

\* If you don't see the template chooser window, click the Add button or choose *File > New Site*.



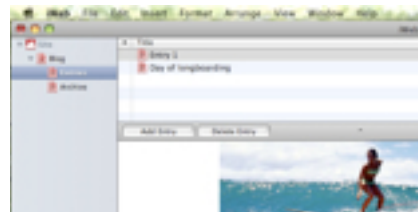
### 2. In the template chooser, click one of the themes on the left

### 3. Select the Blog template on the right and click 'Choose'

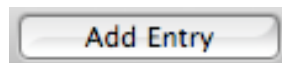
\* The selected template has a yellow border around it.



### 4. Navigate between pages using the Sidebar on the left and use the panel at the top to move between different blog entries

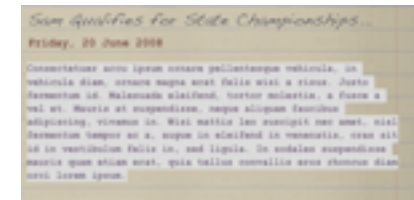


To add new blog entries, click the Add Entry button

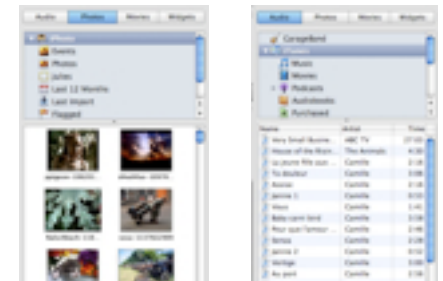


### 5. Double click the place-holder text to enter your own titles or body text, or to change the date

Single click the place-holder to move, resize or delete the placeholder



### 6. Use the media browser to locate photos, audio or movies, then just drag and drop on top of the image place-holder to add media to site



### 8. To publish site, select *File > Publish Entire Site*

Select 'Publish to: Local Folder'

To publish site on the internet, you will need a domain name. If you don't have one, you can trial Mobile Me for free. Simply go to [www.me.com](http://www.me.com)



## Creating a More Advanced Blog

Add a new page, like a homepage, a podcast page or a photos page



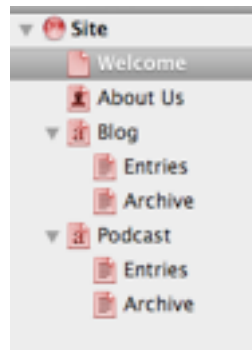
\*Click the Add button or go to *File < New Page*. Select the desired theme and template for your new page.



\*The theme of the page can be changed by clicking the 'Theme' button.



Organize the order of your webpages in the left sidebar, by dragging and dropping the pages into the desired order. The page on top of the list is the homepage when published to the web.



Add Widgets, like a Google Map, using the Media Browser



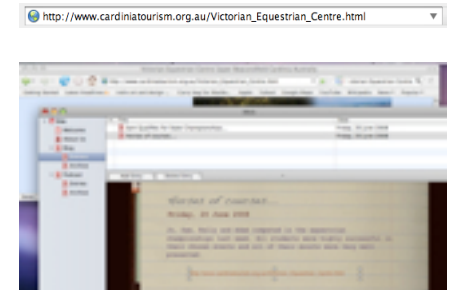
\*Click this icon to open the Media Browser if it isn't open already. Select the Widget tab and drag and drop the widget you would like onto a placeholder or into the desired location.



Add links to other pages or websites

\*Drag and drop the URL from the address bar in your web browser onto your webpage.

NOTE: While you are editing your page, the hyperlink is turned off. You can turn them on in the Link Inspector.



You can publish site to Mobile Me, an FTP Server or a Local Folder. Select "Site" in the left sidebar to enter publishing details.

\* You will need your Mobile Me account details, FTP server settings when you want to publish your site.
