# Trailers

use trailers to have students think about the important parts of their story

great for assessing main ideas / key events

Identifies and analyses main ideas and recurring themes in and between texts.

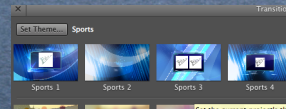
Storyboard - great for writing the words

## Working with Clips

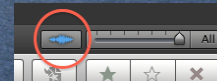
Make a new project using the sports theme

Add 5 clips to the project - related or not

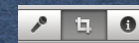
Investigate the Sports related transitions and titles

Try editing the footage - Ken Burns, Fit, Crop

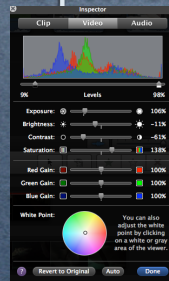




# Working with Video

Video Effects - see what they all do

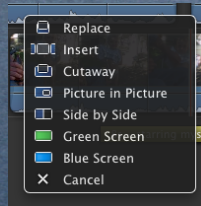


# Working with Video

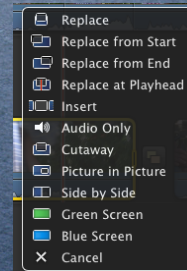
(Make sure Advanced tools are on in Preferences)

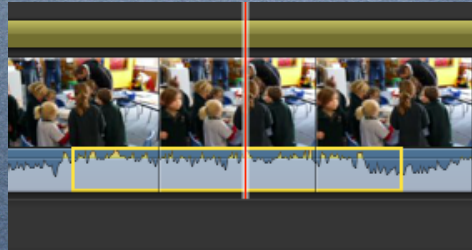
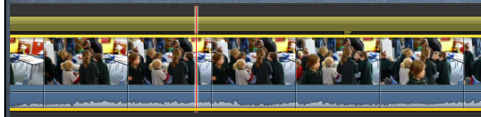
