## iMovie Project

Put together your video clips, photos, slides, and music here to create a Movie

## Event Library

A collection of all the recorded video that you can use in your movie. is organised as 'Events'



## Viewer

Preview your video here

## iMovie Toolbar

Most of the tools you will need are available here

## Source Video

Shows all of the video footage as a series of film strips where you preview and select footage

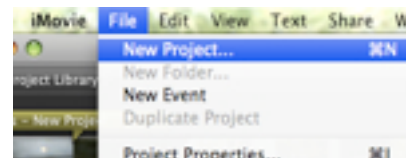
## Creating a Basic Movie

1. Open iMovie \*Click the iMovie icon



To start a new movie project go to File> New Project

Give project a meaningful name and click create. iMovie will automatically save your project as you work on it

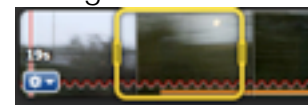


2. Preview footage from the Event Library. Use the spacebar to stop and start preview.

TIP To preview, you can:

- View all footage by clicking outside the footage
- View a small bit of footage by clicking on the footage
- Drag your mouse over the footage (this is called skimming)

3. Click on footage to make a selection. Drag the handles of the yellow box to increase or decrease selection. Drag and drop the footage into the iMovie project.

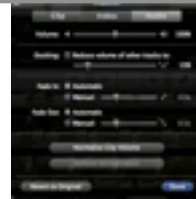

4. Adjust the volume, brightness and add effects to your selected footage



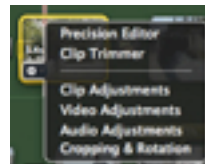
Click on the 'i' icon in the toolbar to open the 'Inspector' and use the tabs to navigate between options



OR



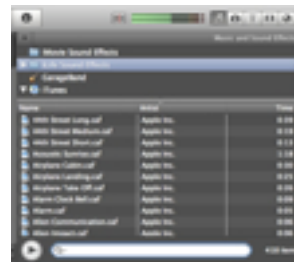
Select the film strip and click the cog icon in the bottom left to make adjustments



5. Add Music and Sound effects



Click the Music button to browse music and sound effects. Double click sound files to preview. Drag and Drop the desired sound files into the desired position in your iMovie project.

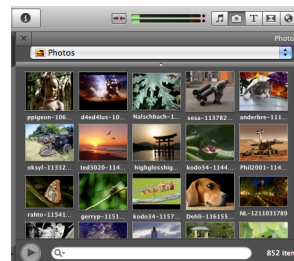


There are a number of other features that will help you build your movie project. You can:

- Add Photos



Click the Photos browser and drag and drop images into your iMovie project.



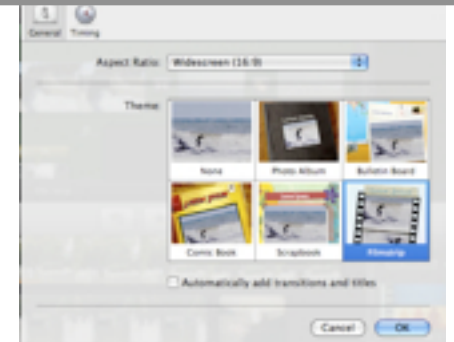
- Add a Voiceover



Click the microphone icon to open the Voice Recorder. Then click where you would like to start recording in your iMovie project.

- Give your movie a theme which automatically adds transitions, titles and backgrounds to your movie

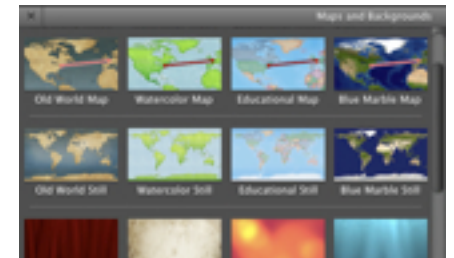
Go to *File > Project Properties...* Select the desired theme for your movie



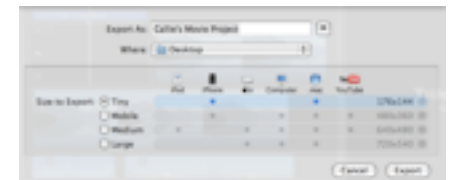
Manually add titles, transitions, maps and backgrounds to your movie using these buttons on the toolbar



Drag and drop desired effect into movie project



6. Export and share your movie
- Select *Share > Export Movie...*
- Select a format based on the recommendations given and click export
