

Making a Digital Story Using Keynote

Ideas for making pictures

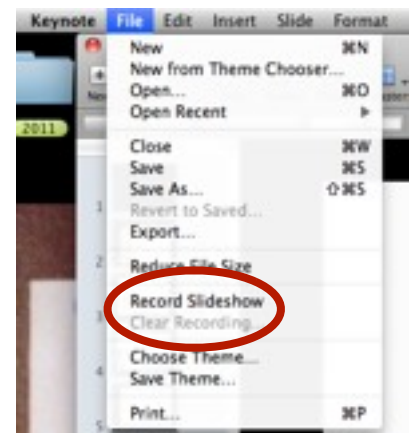
1. Pictures from **Tux Paint** (Take a screen shot of each picture/save to a folder or desktop ...command, shift, 4 takes a photo)
2. **Draw pictures...**take photo of each picture with camera or Photo Booth
3. Use copyright free images
4. **Import movies** that have been made (ie. Stykz, SAM, Scratch)
5. Make a folder for storing your pictures
(Optional....will make inserting pictures easier)
6. ***Drag your pictures into iPhoto....make a folder/give it your story's name)***

Open Keynote...Steps...

1. Choose 'black' or 'white' theme
2. Click on each text box and delete it
3. Click on the slide on left, once...command D, to duplicate it (as many times as you like)
4. If your pictures are in iPhoto go to the Media button and choose 'Photos', then 'iPhoto' Choose your story pictures folder..
(if your pictures aren't in iPhoto, you can still drag them on each slide one at a time)
5. Drag in one picture for each slide....
6. Add a text box for text if required

Adding Narration...

7. Go to File, slide to 'Record Slideshow'
You can change each slide by tapping the space bar
To **STOP** recording, **tap the space bar**



8. If you would like to start again, go to File, Clear Recording, then back to Step 7, to start again
