  - they may be collecting reading samples, reflections on learning etc.

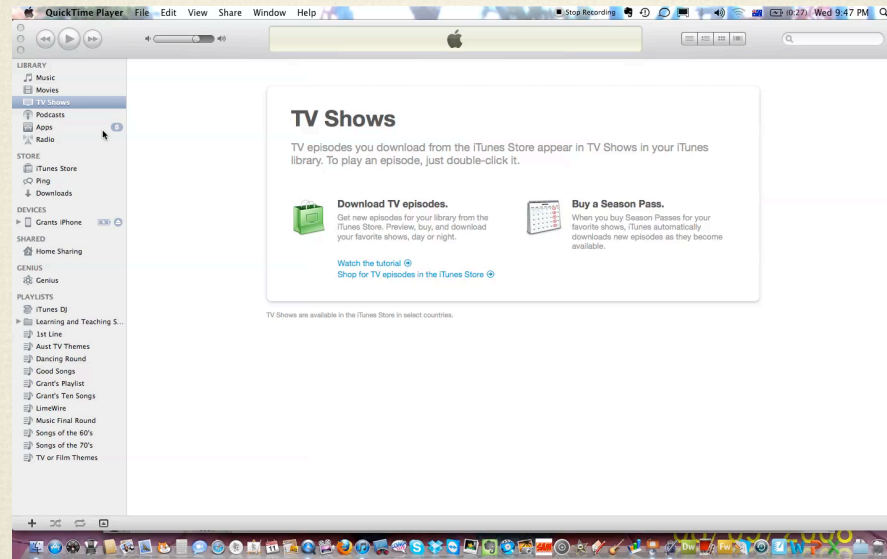
