Prerequisite: Science 10-->(70% for 112 and 80% for 111) **AND**  
Math 10 ---->(70% for 112 and 80% for 111)

Materials: A section in a binder devoted to Chemistry 112/111 with loose leaf and graph paper. (Since I give handouts and supplementary work, a binder is more useful than a notebook.) A calculator will be essential in some units. You should have your textbook with you every day.

Attendance: Attendance is very important with any college/university preparatory course. If you know you will be away in advance, please find out what you will be missing ahead of time. Lateness: After you have been late twice, you will receive a warning. At three lates and every time after that, you will be asked to make up time during either a Monday or Wednesday noon hour.

Food/Drinks: Because having good habits in a Chemistry lab situation is so important, I ask that you refrain from eating, chewing or drinking anything in the lab. It is also extremely important that you develop the habit of washing your hands before you leave the lab any time we are working there.

Midterm/Tests: There will be a midterm during the first or second week of November. A test will be given at the end of each chapter. Please note that tests are not returned, you will receive results and should come in at noon hour if you wish to go over them with me. The lowest \*test\* will be dropped if you have good attendance and are present on the day of the test for all tests and the midterm( \*Sorry, this does not apply to the midterm:)\*

Homework/Reading Assignments: Homework is mandatory and essential to your success in this course. It will be given regularly and will be periodically checked by some short quizzes. (20-30 minutes per night of study/homework)  
Regular study is important to the subject of Chemistry so it is recommended that you read each chapter though twice and review your work/notes regularly.  
Please put the date at the top of your work so that it is easy to find when I do homework checks.

Exemptions: The following criteria apply: ① Attendance 8 days max. (Note needed for each absence)  
② Mark of 80% ③ Attitude/Cooperation  
④ Work habits/Homework

Miss a test?: Please make sure I see an excuse. Missed tests are usually written at noon hour on one of two make-up days scheduled in October and December.
