MAKING CONNECTIONS

- ◆ Making connections with your Mac or iPad can be done in a variety of ways for a variety of purposes.
- ◆ Ethernet cable / Wi-fi - accessing the internet
- ◆ Bluetooth - sharing files; adding cordless devices
- ◆ 3G / 4G - using your phone provider for internet access
- ◆ Apple TV - accessing iTunes; viewing and sharing your own music, videos and photos; special channels



WHAT IS WI-FI?



1. A computer's wireless adapter translates data into a radio signal and transmits it using an antenna.
2. A wireless router receives the signal and decodes it. The router sends the information to the Internet using a physical, wired Ethernet connection.

WHAT CAN I USE IT FOR? and why?

- ◆ Accessing the internet without cabling
- ◆ When you don't have a 3G connection
- ◆ Increased mobility
- ◆ Multiple devices

Always password protect your wi-fi



HOW DO I ACCESS WI-FI?

- ◆ Make sure your wi-fi is turned on - check in settings for iPad and system preferences (network) on a mac or click the wi-fi symbol at the top of the screen
- ◆ Your Mac device will automatically scan for networks
- ◆ Select the appropriate network. If you see a lock you will need a password
- ◆ Once you have connected your device will remember the network for next time

PROVIDING YOUR OWN Wi-Fi



Wireless Modem

- Multiple connections
- Must be plugged into wired connection
- Cheapest plans



Mobile Broadband

- Single connection
- Plugs into computer
- Not for iPad
- Travels with you



Mobile Broadband

- Multiple connections
- No need to plug in anywhere
- Travels with you

WHAT IS BLUETOOTH?



Bluetooth is a wireless technology for exchanging data over **short distances**. The chip can be plugged into computers, digital cameras and mobile phones.

WHAT CAN I USE IT FOR?

- ◆ Transferring files from one device to another (computer only)
- ◆ Connect to:
 - handsfree headset
 - keyboards
 - mouse
 - speakers
 - control devices



HOW DO I USE BLUETOOTH?

iPad



Go to settings
Select Bluetooth



- * Slide switch next to Bluetooth on
- * Your iPad will search for Bluetooth enabled devices
- * Select desired device

HOW DO I USE BLUETOOTH?



- * Your iPad will now connect to the device or be asked to enter a passcode
- * Enter the code or tap pair

HOW DO I USE BLUETOOTH? Mac



Go to System Preferences
and select Bluetooth
or
Click the Bluetooth icon
at the top of your screen

Click set up new device
Select the device

Turn off Bluetooth when you are not using it
