

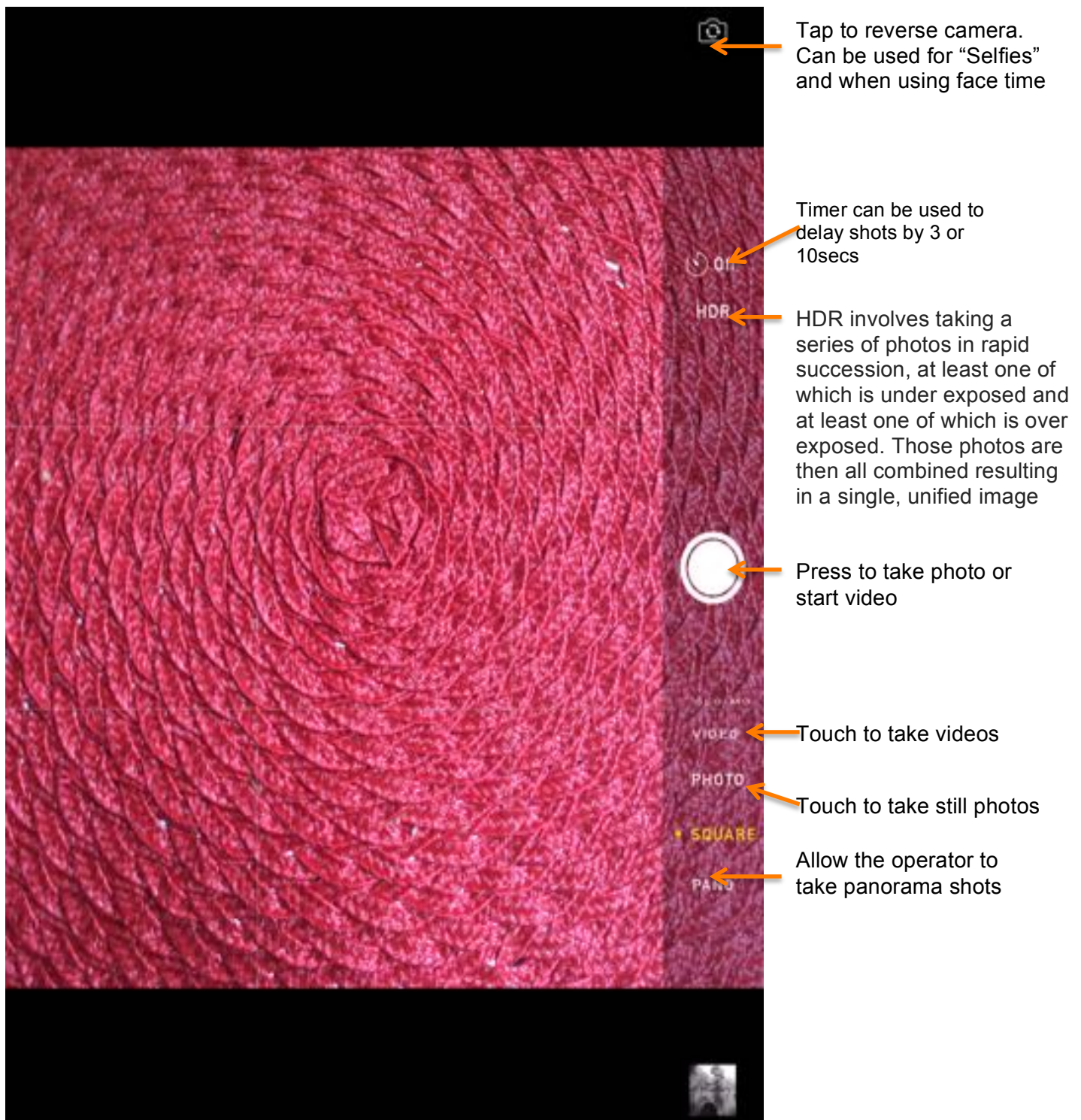
Get To Know your Camera App

This is the camera icon on your Ipad if you are using System 7 or later.

If you can't see this icon on your home screen Go to Setting > General> Restrictions and make sure the camera is turned on



Open the Camera App and explore these “tools” within the Camera App.



Task Taking a Photo with your iPad

- 1 Launch the Camera app from your iPhone or iPad's Home screen.
- 2 Move your iPhone or iPad around until what you see on the screen matches the image you want to capture.
- 3 Rotate your iPhone or iPad from portrait to landscape or vice versa to change the orientation. (You'll see the icons change as confirmation.)
- 4 Tap the Shutter button to take your picture

Now Take a Selfie

- Tap camera icon in top right corner to reverse image.
- Take a photo of yourself

Task Exploring the Video Option

- Launch the Camera app from the Home screen of your iPhone or iPad.
- Swipe from left to right across the bottom to switch from Photo to Video mode. (Or just tap the word Video.)
- Tap the Record button to start your video.
- Tap the Stop button to end your video.

Now create a time-lapse video on your iPad

Before beginning, make sure that your iPhone or iPad supports time-lapse mode. Launch the Camera app on your iPhone or iPad running iOS 8 or higher.

- Enter time-lapse mode by swiping all the way to the right so the time-lapse option is yellow.
- Tap on the record button to start your time-lapse.
- Let it go until you're ready to stop it. This may be a 15 second period, or much longer.
- When you're done capturing, tap the record button again to end the time-lapse.

Task Take a Panoramic Photo

- Tap Pano in Camera Mode
- Press record button and move iPad across the view
- Tap arrow to change the direction of the operation. Try this as well as moving from left to right
