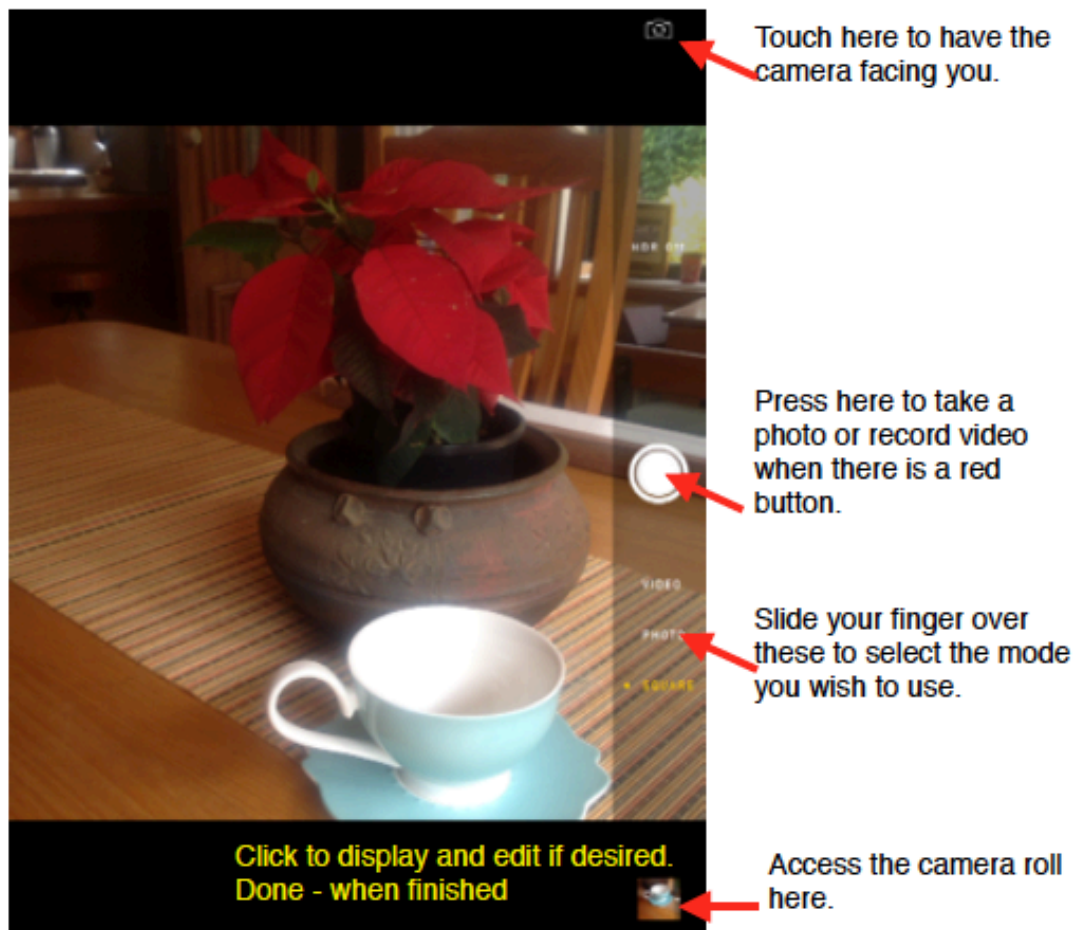
### Getting To Know Your Camera App

This is the camera icon on your Ipad if you are using System 7 or later.

If you can't see this icon on your home screen  
Go to Setting > General> Restrictions and make sure  
the camera is turned on



Open the Camera App and explore these “tools” within the Camera App.



### **Task 1 Taking a Photo with your iPad**

- 1 Launch the Camera app from your iPhone or iPads Home screen.
- 2 Move your iPhone or iPad around until what you see on the screen matches the image you want to capture.
- 3 Rotate your iPhone or iPad from portrait to landscape or vice versa to change the orientation. (You'll see the icons change as confirmation.)
- 4 Tap the Shutter button to take your picture or use the volume switch on the side of your device

### **Now Take a Selfie**

- Tap camera icon in top right corner to reverse image.
- Take a photo of yourself

### **Task 2 Exploring the Video Option**

- Launch the Camera app from the Home screen of your iPhone or iPad.
- Swipe from left to right across the bottom to switch from Photo to Video mode. (Or just tap the word Video.)
- Tap the Record button to start your video.
- Tap the Stop button to end your video.

### **Task 3 Take a Panoramic Photo (on later models)**

- Tap Pano in Camera Mode
- Press record button and move iPad across the view
- Tap arrow to change the direction of the operation. Try this as well as moving from left to right

### **Screen Capture**

There is another way of taking a photo of image you have on your device that you would like save for example a map.

You can capture the screen by using the **Sleep/Wake** and **Home buttons**.

- Press and hold the Sleep/Wake button on the top or side of your device.
- Immediately press and release the Home button.
- To find your screenshot, go to the Photos app > Albums and tap Camera Roll.

### **Task 4. Take a Screen Capture From Your Device**

- Following the instructions above take a screen capture of your home screen

**NOTE:** The photos you take will be found in the  
PHOTO APP on  
Your Device. You can edit your Photos from that App.
