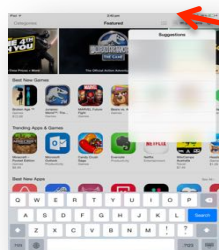


Exploring Apps

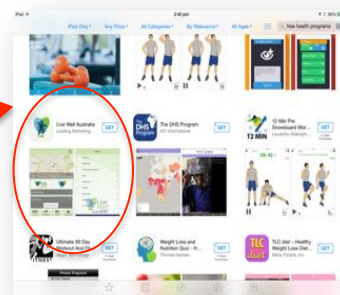
What is an App? An app (short for application) **is** a self-contained program or piece of software designed to fulfill a particular purpose. Apps can be downloaded by a user to any mobile device.

If this is the first time you have used the APP Store this is what you do.

Apps that may be used to enhance the use of your iPad can be located via connecting to the App Store that looks like this on your iPad. Tap on the icon to open it



Once into the App Store simply type in the search bar an area of interest eg “free health programs”

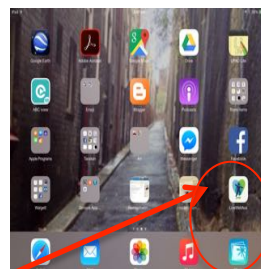


Many apps will appear scroll down to you find the one or those that best suit you interests and tap on **GET**



The word **GET** then turns into **INSTALL**. Tap install

Type in your Apple ID (itunes ID) and the app will start to download. The download can be observed by a blue line moving around the space where the word Install originally was.



Once the App is completed downloaded it will appear on your desktop. Open it and explore. If you don’t want the app...just delete.

Task

Now it's your turn to explore. These are only suggestions.

Look for at least three Apps that you might like to use. Maybe consider looking at some service Apps.

Eg if you use Centrelink there is a Centrelink App, or

Fires Near Me NSW (bushfire alerts), or

If you like the Conversation Hour with Richard Fidler on ABC you can download the Podcasting App and then access his sessions, or

ABC iview, where you can catch up on ABC programs you have missed or may like to watch at time suitable to you

Think about your interests and look at downloading some Apps that might extend or challenge your thinking. These could be games. eg type in Free Word Games, Free Jigsaws Puzzles, Free Sudoka; Free Solitaire; Free Crosswords; Free Puzzles, Brain Games, Scrabble and so on

If you have interests in Art, Cooking, Patch-working, Cars or Bikes, just type in what you might be looking for eg Sketching Apps; Cooking Games; Car sales etc

For those who like to write or create documents, an interesting word processor you might to look at is "PAGES".

For Music lovers SPOTIFY is free and fun.

For readers maybe "IBOOKS" might be your thing.

There are so many apps that you can check out you will be surprised at what is available.

Be brave just have a look and see what's out there.

HOWEVER, when looking at apps, if you don't want to pay for them make sure the App is **FREE**.
