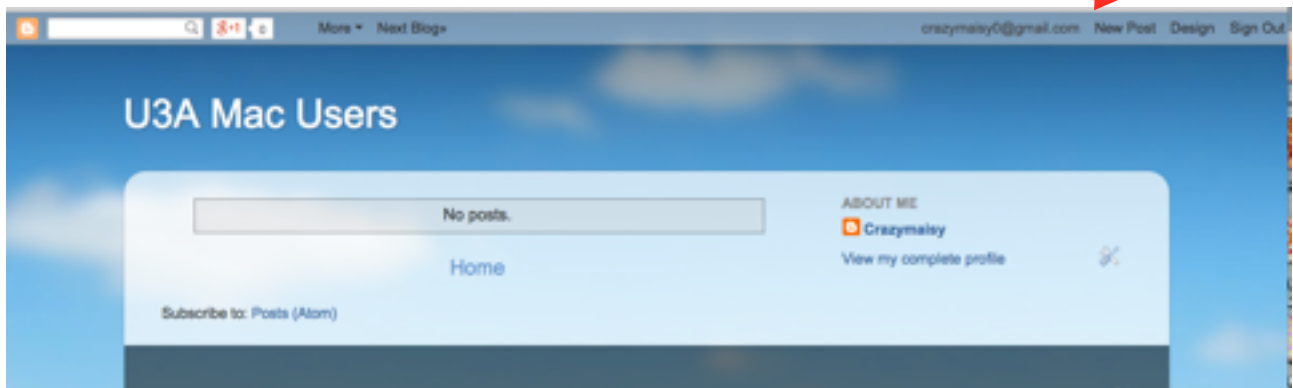


# Creating and Sharing a Blog Part 2

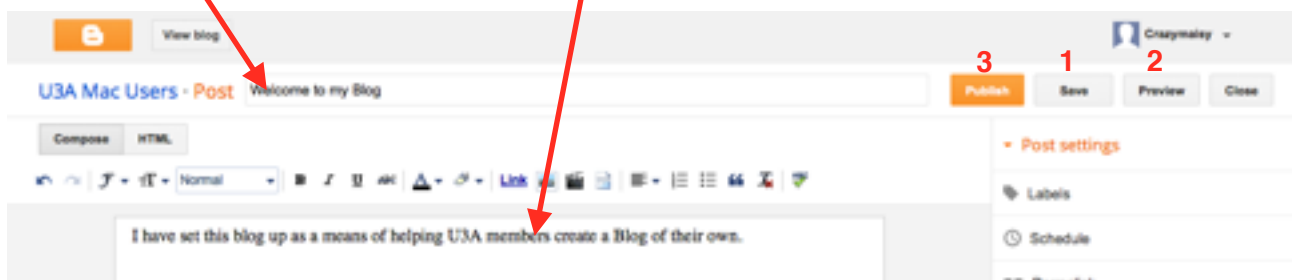
## Posting to Your Blog

Enter the URL of your blog into the search field. Sign in if you haven't already (top right hand corner).

Select New post (top right hand corner).



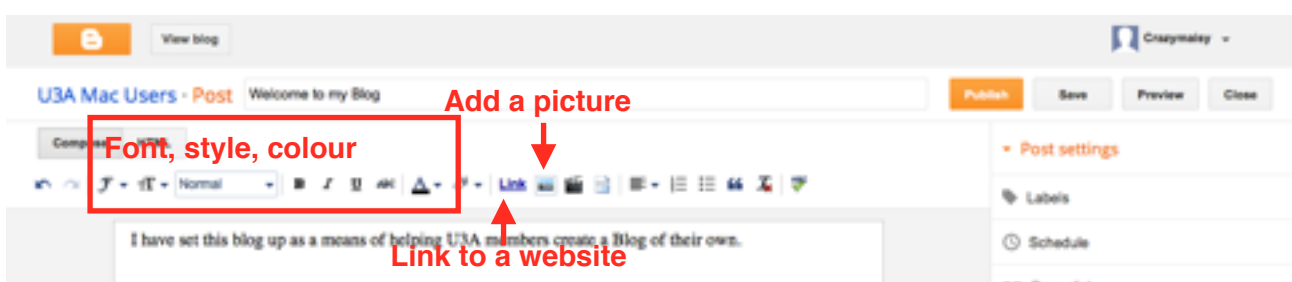
Name your post then click in the body box and write what you want to say.



- 1 By clicking **Save** your post will be saved so you can come back to it later. At this stage only you can see it.
- 2 You can see what your post will look like before you publish by clicking **Preview**.
- 3 By clicking **Publish** your post will be available on the internet and anybody who has the address can see it.

## Computer (and iPad from New Post)

You can change the font, colour, style and more of your posts using the tool bar above the body box.

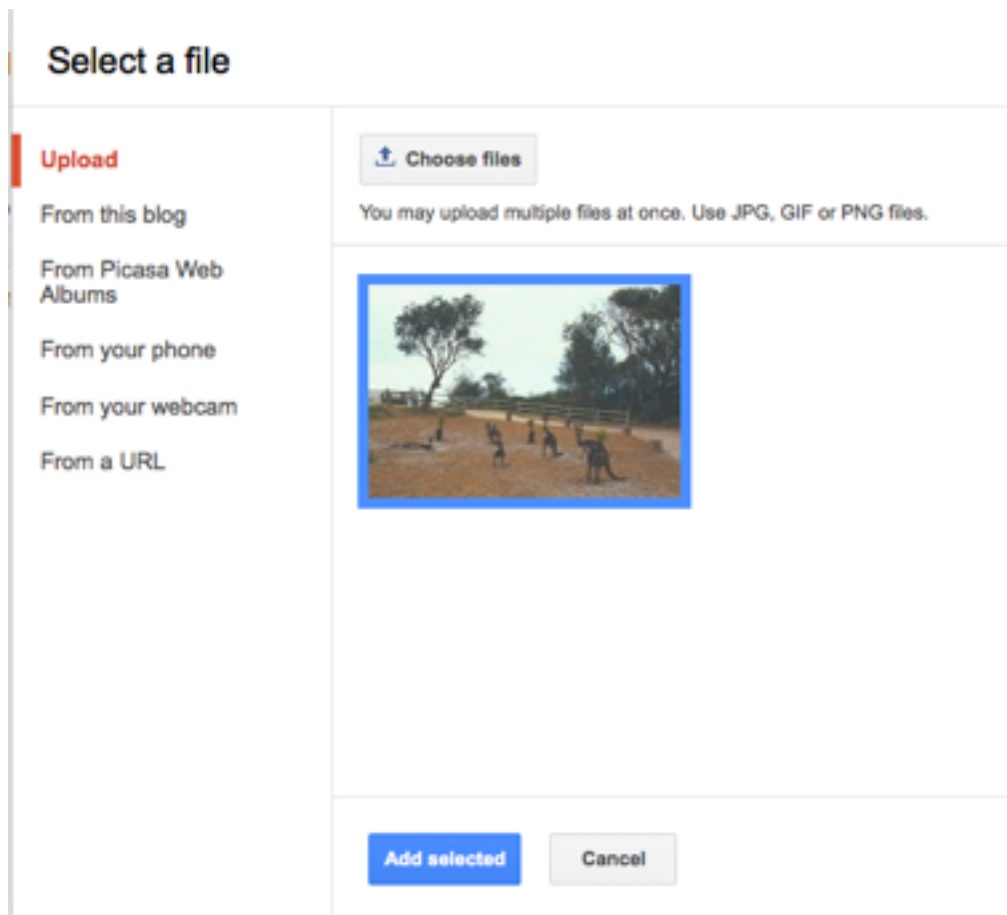


## Adding Photos

Place your cursor where you want the photo to go.

### Computer

Click the picture icon.



Select **upload**.....**Choose files**.....find your picture files from iPhoto, thumb drive of desktop.....open. The files will upload.

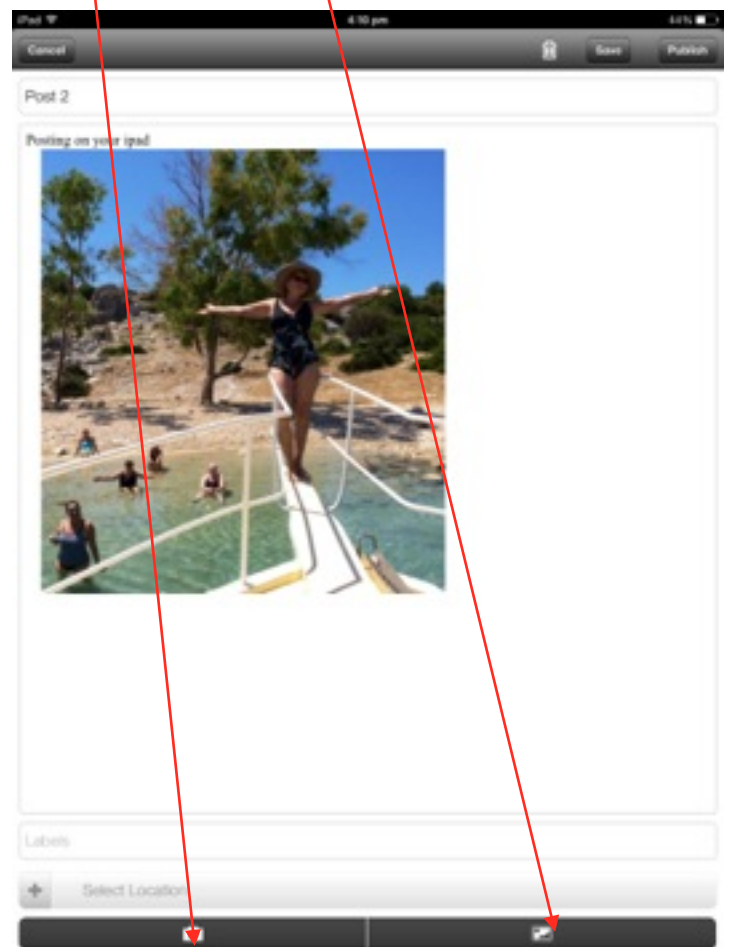
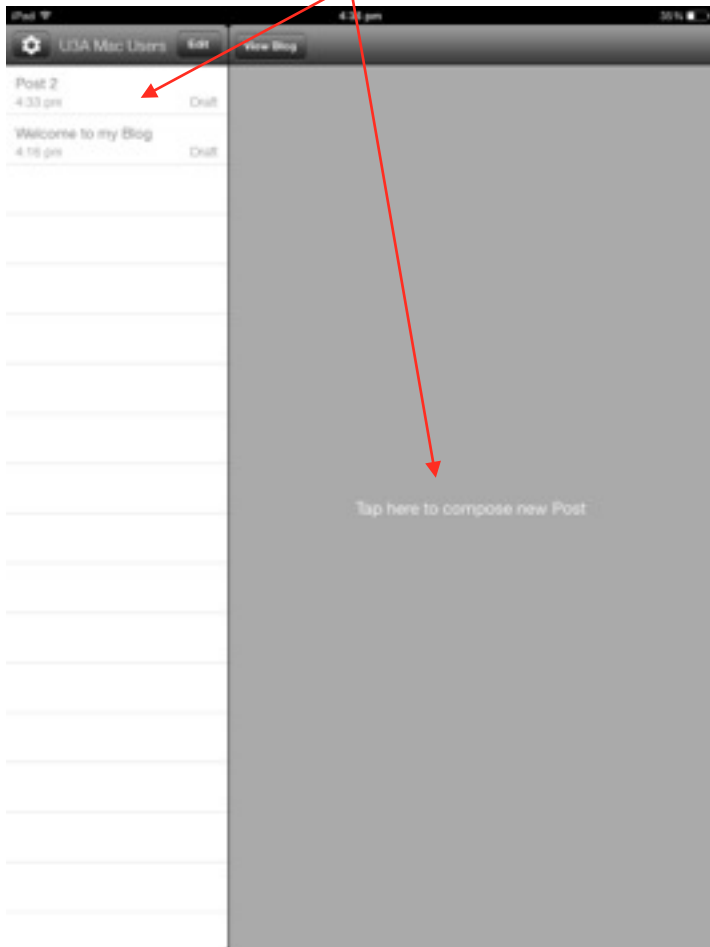
Select the photo you wish to place (it will be outlined) and click **Add Selected**.

## iPad using Blogger App

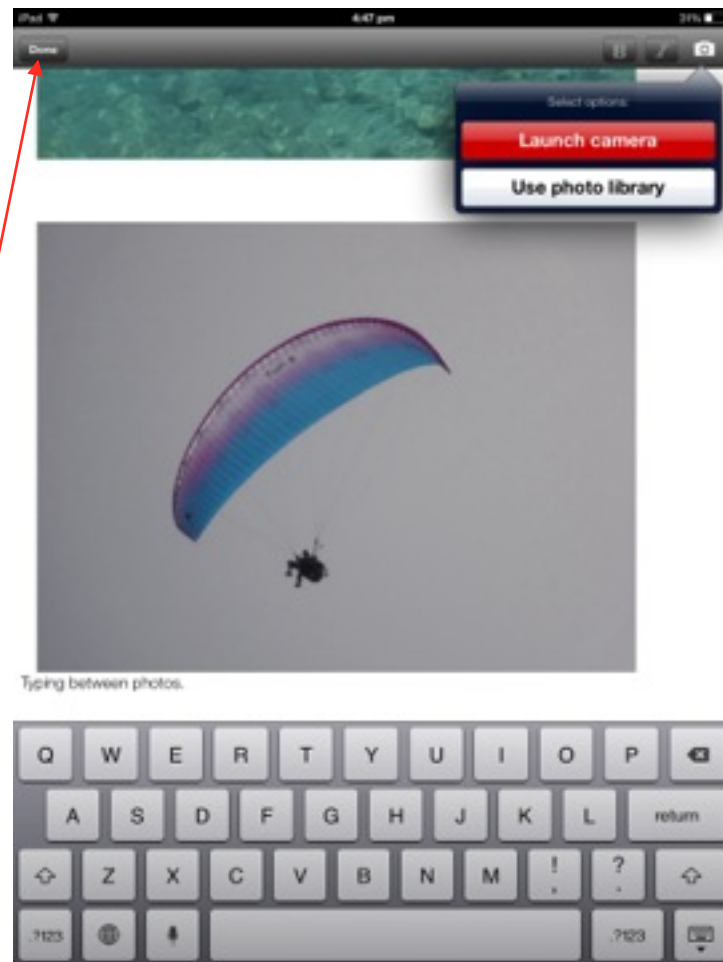
Open **Blogger**. Sign in if you haven't already.

Tap to **compose new post** or select saved post and click **pencil symbol** to edit.

At the bottom of the page you will see a camera icon and picture icon. Click one of these to add your photo. The camera icon allows you to take a photo and place it directly into the blog. The picture icon accesses your photo library. I prefer this method as I can edit the photos before posting.



If you are typing between photos you can insert photos by clicking on the **camera icon** in the top right hand corner. You will then have the choice of launching your camera or using your photo library.



Click **Done** when finished and either Save or Publish your post.

You can make changes to your posts at any time. Simply edit the post and hit the Publish button after you have made your changes.
