Google Maps– When you're travelling through unfamiliar territory, sometimes turn-by-turn navigation just isn't enough. A new design update on Google Maps has made even easy to get around. It offers satellite imagery, street maps, 360° panoramic views of streets real-time traffic conditions and route planning for traveling by foot, car, bicycle or public transport.



Maps—Apple Maps is a mapping service web mapping developed by Apple. It comes with your iPhone, iPad. And iWatch. It provides directions and estimated times of arrival for automobile, pedestrian, and public transportation navigation. Apple Maps also features the unique *Flyovers* mode, a feature that enables a user to explore densely populated cities and towns in a 3D landscape composed of models of buildings and structures.
