

## Ipads Tricks and Tips You May Like To Revisit

### 1. Controlling Your iPad Notifications

By going to Settings > Notifications, you can decide which apps can pop up alerts, which have notifications at the top of the screen, and which appear in Notification Center. This means you can make sure that noisy apps don't clog things up for you, and you notice the important things.

### 2. If You Have an iPhone and iPad and haven't the Find My Phone APP in the App Store

Apple's Find My iPad works for all iCloud users. In Settings > iCloud, enter your Apple ID and then turn Find My iPad on near the bottom of the screen. Now if you lose your iPad, you can go to [icloud.com](http://icloud.com) or use Find My iPhone on another device to locate the iPad. If you have a Wi-Fi-only model, it will need to be connected to a Wi-Fi network for this to work.

### 3. Revisit the Short Cut to return to the top of a screen in Safari

Scrolling all the way up to the top of a long page can be irritating. That's why Apple included a shortcut: **just tap on the title bar** at the top of the screen to automatically jump to the top. This could work in other apps so why not try it and see.

### 4. Find text on a page

Type the word or phrase you are looking for into the search box in the top and if it appears on the page then you will see an 'On This Page' section in the search results. Tap that to see the word highlighted on the page. Try this iBooks, pages( under the spanner)

### 5. Fast app switching

It's not necessary to close one app and then scroll through your apps to find the one you want. Just open the iPad's **multitasking menu by swiping upwards with four fingers** or **double-tapping the home button**. You'll see all of your recently opened apps. Scroll right and you'll see even more. Just tap the one you want to switch quickly. This is especially useful if you want to copy-and-paste between one app and another. Swipe one up to quite it.

### 6. Ending a sentence quickly

When you're typing you can simply double tap the space bar to end a sentence. It will add a period and a space for you, so you can start the next sentence.

## **7 Using Auto Fill**

The AutoFill feature will automatically put your details into web forms to save you typing them out each time. The best way to set it up is to go into Contacts and set up an entry for yourself with all the details. Now go to *Settings > Safari > AutoFill* and slide *Use Contact Info* to “on” and pick the contact you just created in *My Info*.

## **8. Turn off Need for A Password When Downloading Free Apps.**

You can set up your Ipad so it requires a password for pay app downloads, but not for free ones. To turn off the password requirement, head to Settings -> iTunes & App Store and tap on Password Settings. You want Always Require checked off to make sure you still have to enter a password for paid apps, then you can toggle Require Password off under Free Downloads. Once this is done you no longer have to login to download a free app.

## **9 Turning Off In-App Purchase Notifications( mainly in games)**

\*Navigate to Settings -> General -> Restrictions -> Enable Restrictions. Enter a passcode for Restrictions. You will be asked to enter it twice. Scroll down to the Allowed Content section. Select In-App Purchases -> OFF.
