Having had several apps open by now. Use the short cut to close multiple apps as shown a few weeks ago. Clue-it has to do with your home button

Task 8

Can you remember how to retrieve a deleted email? Send yourself a test email. When it arrives move it to the trash. Remember how to get it back. Clue it has to do with shaking!

1. A New Tip using bold, italic or underlining when you are writing an email.

Type a test email. Highlight the word you want to make bold, italic or underline
When the cues come up tap on the BIU tab



2. Taking a Photo with the volume button on your ipad

When you have your camera app open and are about to take a photo, you might find it easier to use the volume button on your ipad rather than the button in the camera app. Have a go and see what you think

3. One Last New Tip for This Term Using Spotlight Search

- Swipe down on any page on your device while not in an app. Be careful not to swipe from the very top of the screen, because this will just give you access to your notification center.
- When you swipe down, a search bar will appear at the top of the iPad and the on-screen keyboard will pop up.
- To search, simply start typing.
- Try typing in camera and the camera app will immediately appear.
- Try typing in Wikipedia and see what happens
- Try searching for one of your contacts by just typing in their name

The best feature of Spotlight Search is the ability to quickly launch an app. Spotlight search lets you quickly search your entire ipad for the app.
