

## Editing Your Photos



### iPhoto

iPhoto is Apple's own editing app. All photos on your camera roll and Photos app will be visible.

This app allows more sophisticated and detailed photo editing than the Photos app.

At the bottom of the page you will see 3 categories Photos, Albums and Projects.

Photos are organised by dates.

Albums can only be created using the **Photos app**.

Projects allows you to create a web journal, Slideshow or Photobook.

### Editing your photos.

- Select a photo by tapping on it from photos or within an album. You can change your selection by scrolling across each photo. Tap the question mark at the top of the page to see what does what.



These tools allow you to edit your photos with more control. Try each one. Hit the arrow button at the top to undo if you don't like the effect.

## Creating a Project

You can create a project from either Photos, Albums or Projects.



### *From Photos tab*

Select a photo

Select Share

Select type of project

Choose photos - select from thumbnails

Select next

Select new Web Journal, Slideshow or photo book

Select create

OR

You can select one you have already created and add these photos to it.



### *From Albums Tab*

Select a photo

Select Share

Select type of project

Choose from Selected, Flagged or All or choose the photos you want from the album

Select new Web Journal, Slideshow or photo book.

Name the project. Choose the layout

Select create

OR

You can select one you have already created and add these photos to it.

### *From Projects tab*

Select the + button

Select type of project

## Web Journals

Tap Edit to make changes.

Select the 3 dots ... at the top of the page to select your theme, grid size and layout.

Select the plus to add:

Photos, Headers, Text, Memories, Notes, Quotes, Flags, Currency, Food, Day, Map, Weather, a divider, a space, a new page

To move photos or objects touch and hold. The photo or object will pulse, drag to new location.

To resize a photo tap once and you will see a blue frame. Tap, hold and drag the appropriate blue dot until you have the size you want. You can also edit individual photos from the menu above the blue frame.

Text can be changed slightly as well. Tap once and select from 3 fonts and 3 justifications.



## Photo Books

Tap the 3 dots ... at the top of the page to select size, theme, number of pages ( how many photos per page).

Touch and hold to move a page.

Touch and select trash to delete a page.

Touch then touch and hold to move a photo.

Double tap to open a page.

Touch to select a place in a layout - select photo to add.

You can drag photos to the bottom of the page for later use.

DON'T FORGET THE QUESTION MARK to give you hints.
