

Sharing Your Photos Creatively

There is always the Photos 'Sharing' option to allow others to access your photos but why not use other apps to share creatively.

These are just a few of the many available. If you would like to learn about these download from the app store.

Slide X (Free + Pro \$2.99)



Great if you are looking to create a simple slideshow. You can share on a large screen through Apple TV or create a movie to email or publish.

1. Download the app.
2. Open app and select create a slide. Give permission to access your photos. You should be presented with your albums.

3. Open the desired album and select the photos you want to share. They will automatically fill the slideshow timeline.

4. Tap the first slide and give your show a name. You can change the font here and decide how the title appears. Adjust the time of the title. Change the font of the title.

5. To add transitions (how one slide moves to the next) tap the small box between the photos. Tap each one and watch the example given. Repeat for each transition or apply the same transition to each slide.

6. Editing your show at a later time. From the Home menu select Gallery. Tap the arrow to the right of your project. Select project details. Select the icon at the top right of the screen to reveal your options.

7. Read through How to Use

8. Add two more photos.

9. Add an effect to a photo.

10. Select an image to add a title.

11. Go into preferences to decide on duration of pictures.

12. Create a video of your slideshow.

Adobe Slate (Free)



1. You will need to set up a free Adobe ID to use this app or you can login with Facebook. Follow the prompts to sign up then sign in.

2. Upon entering you will see examples of stories created by others. Explore a few by sliding your finger up the page. You can close each book by selecting close in the top left hand corner.

3. Time to create your own book. Tap the + sign. Select a theme (top right menu). This can be changed at any time.

4. Add a Title and subtitle if you wish.

5. Add a photo - you will need to give permission for the app to access your photo library if you wish to use photos from there but you have other options.

6. By scrolling up you have other option to add photos, text, links and more to your book.

7. Add one of each type to your book. Leave the slideshow till last. Where ever you see a + sign you can add something.

8. Once you are happy with your book you can preview it. (Look at the top right hand corner)

9. Time to share. You can elect to make your story public or private. Your story will be uploaded and the time it takes will depend on the number of photos and the speed of your connection. Once done you will receive a link that will take them to your story. You have other options for sharing as well, including Facebook.

Sharing Your Photos Creatively

Stellar (Free)



Another easy to use app that allows you to create small 'books'. to share your photos and short movies. You can add text as well as change the layout to suit your story. You are initially limited to 20 photos and/or movies per story but can add more later..

1. Download open app. Sign up. Again you will need to give permission to access your photos.

2. Explore some of the examples on the home screen or the Star screen..

3. Create your own story. Select the + sign.
4. Select your theme. Next.
5. Select your media (keep it small for practice 5 -10 photos). Import.
6. Add a title. Tap the word title. add your own. Tap the pencil. Change font, size and colour.
7. Slide to the left to reveal each page. Add information as required.
8. As you go to a page select Layouts. Choose your preferred layout. Add text if necessary.
9. Add another text page. Add another photo page.
10. To remove a page tap the pages button then the cross underneath the page you wish to delete.
11. Save your draft.
12. Privacy. If you publish without editing your privacy settings anybody who accesses Stellar can see your story. If you wish to keep it private go to the person icon then settings in the top left hand corner. Turn on private account.
13. When you are ready publish your story. You can select from emailing the link, Facebook and more.
