

iPads Revision 8 July

Adding a bit of fun to your emails or messages. There are two ways this can be managed

1. Go to Settings>General> Keyboard > Tap on Keyboard> add New Keyboard> scroll through until you locate Emoji> Tap > return to your email and when you wish to add an Emoji from your keypad Tap the icon that looks like a world globe and you will find you have a number of emoji's to from which to select.

 - Go to the Apps icon on your iPad and download an a free emoji's application (App)
 - From that App you can send emails or messages with the emoji you wish to use

Increasing the size of your text

- Go to Settings>Select General>Scroll to Accessibility> Tap on it> Scroll down to Larger Text >Tap > in the next screen turn on Larger Accessibility size> the scroll down to select the size that suits your vision.

Revisit Maps from last week

Find an Open the Maps icon on your ipad

- If the image comes in as a 3D image> tap on the information icon and return to 2D maps
- Tap on Directions and enter your location and type in a local destination> look at the distance and time it will take you to get there > press start to see your first instruction
- Turn you map into a 3D version and zoom in look at your destination While in maps Tap on the information icon again look and check out the other options available to you. i.e Report a problem



iBooks

- If you have not added the iBook app to your ipad.> Go to Apps and download iBooks (its free)
- Tap >Store and type in “Free Australian Literature”. If there is a book that appeals Tap and download Tap on Library > Collections > Books and you will find the book you have downloaded

Searching through Old Newspapers

- Revisit “Trove” trove.nla.gov.au
- Tap on Newspapers
- Undertake a search for a family member or person of interest from an area where you believe they may have grown up or worked.

Capturing and using Images

- Screen capture an image from the internet. Hold down the on /off button and the home button for a second.
- Find where the photo screen shot has been stored.
- Either a. email the image and don’t forget to reduce the size of the image in doing so.....or if have a document app, such as Pages or Microsoft word for iPad on your ipad, create a card using the image.
