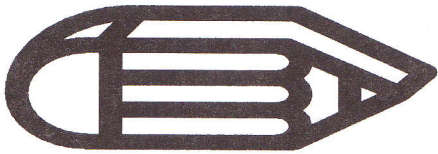

Steps for Spelling Use the step-by-step strategy for studying most spelling words. 1. Look 2. Say 3. Cover 4. Write 5. Check	Divide and Conquer Divide long words into shorter pieces (syllables). Sep/tem/ber night/time	Memory Tricks Link the tricky word with a helper that you can spell. an <u>ant</u> on an elephant Don't <u>eat</u> the <u>leaves</u> !
Problem Parts Mark the problem part and study it extra hard. bridge glasses	Pronouncing for Spelling Pronounce the word as it is spelled with emphasis on the difficult part. Say 'k-not'. Say 'clo-the-s'.	Meaning Helpers Find a related word that gives you a sound clue. heal-health soft-soften
