Critical Thinking: Name of Article Read

Element Questions to Ask Yourself	Your comments (bullet points are fine; extended thinking where you desire is welcome)
Issue/Question: What question (or concern) is at the heart of this account? <i>(What is the thesis statement?)</i>	
Assumption/Belief: What belief is communicated through this story about the role of local people in achieving food security? Based on the story told, does this seem like a reasonable /logical assumption to make?	
Data: What evidence is provided in this account that the approach used by the NGO toward achieving food security is “working”?	
Inferences: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Based on what you’ve read, what “tentative” conclusions/judgements can you make ? 	
Implications: <i>if</i> it is possible to repeat (spread the effect of) the experience in this account, what might we see in the future of food?	
Concepts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What are 1-2 key ideas/concepts you used to think as you read this article? 	
Conclusions (and/or questions, wondering). In general -what is your thinking about the results seen through this individual/community’s experience? -What thoughts do you have about the account, the approach to achieving food security, or the work of the NGO? -What do you wonder?
