

Fulbert of Chartres (c. 970-1028), bishop.

Fulbert became Bishop of Chartres in 1006 and played an important part in ecclesiastical and political affairs. He wrote letters, many to his disciple Hildegard (ed. Behrends, 1976), some sermons (ed. Canal, 1963), poems and hymns. See Behrends on his life and works.
