Preface

THE PRESENT LIST WAS COMPILED IN THE FIRST INSTANCE FOR USE BY CONTRIBUTORS to Fontes Anglo-Saxonici; it was subsequently adopted by the editors of Sources of Anglo-Saxon Literary Culture (SASLC). The abbreviations have also been adopted (in slightly modified form) by the Toronto *Dictionary of Old English*. The list is issued in this form merely as a guide for scholars contributing to these several projects, and is not intended in any sense as a comprehensive bibliography of books known in Anglo-Saxon England. Omissions and errors will be readily apparent to anyone who handles it.

During the course of compilation I have drawn freely on the advice and guidance of Peter Clemoes, Helmut Gneuss, Joyce Hill and Don Scragg. Michael Reeve and Neil Wright helped me with editions of classical texts, Vivien Law with the grammarians, and George Brown with Bede. In the later stages I was able to profit from the criticisms of Pauline Thompson (on behalf of the DOE) and from the meticulous corrections of Fred Biggs (on behalf of SASLC). Remaining errors, however, are entirely my own.

It is hoped to issue revised and updated versions of this list whenever necessary. I should therefore be grateful to learn of errors, omissions, inconsistencies and addenda to the present list.

ABBREVIATIONS FOR SOURCES AND SPECIFICATION OF STANDARD EDITIONS FOR SOURCES

It is the intention of Fontes Anglo-Saxonici and Sources of Anglo-Saxon Literary Culture (SASLC) to record the literary sources used by Anglo-Saxon authors. In order that the citation of sources in the eventual printed registers of these two projects be consistent and mutually intelligible, it is desirable that contributors to both projects use standard abbreviations in referring to the Latin and Old English sources which they identify. This list, which provides abbreviations for the sources most likely to be cited frequently, is arranged as follows:

1. Biblia Sacra: pp. 3-5
2. Named Classical Authors: pp. 6-15
3. Named Patristic Authors: pp. 16-33
4. Named Merovingian and Carolingian Authors: pp. 34-40
5. Named Insular Authors: pp. 41-50
6. Anonymous Writings: pp. 51-6

It is essential that contributors to both projects cite sources from editions which are standard among those scholars working on the projects (this is particularly desirable in the case of prose works for which there is no conventional editorial paragraphing; in such cases reference must perforce be made to page, column or line numbers of printed editions). Editions which are to be used by all contributors are specified, within square brackets, after each entry in the following list.

It is impossible that the list should include every work which every contributor will wish to cite. In the case of a work which does not appear in the list, the contributor is asked to select an appropriate edition (in the case of Fontes, in consultation with the Executive Secretary in question) and to devise an abbreviation on the principles which have been applied in the list and which

should be readily detectable from a study of it. Contributors to SASLC should include new abbreviations - with all relevant bibliographical information - at the conclusion of each entry.

For contributors to Fontes using the standard editions specified in this list within square brackets, see Guidelines for Contributors, 5c. For the form of abbreviation to be used in citing an edition (in sections E5 - E10 of the entry slips), and for the list of cited editions which must accompany each submission, see Guidelines, 6.

For contributors to SASLC, the abbreviations in the present list will be most frequently used in part D of the headnote.

6. ANONYMOUS WRITINGS

The immense variety and number of anonymous writings which were in circulation during the early Middle Ages make it impossible to devise a comprehensive set of abbreviations, or even to enunciate comprehensive guidelines according to which such abbreviations might be devised. In listing anonymous writings, however, there is one procedure which must be followed in each case, namely that the abbreviation for each such work must invariably be preceded by the letters ANON. (whether the work in question is by one datable and localizable but unidentifiable anonymous author, or whether it is a work which evolved during the course of years and which varies from manuscript to manuscript). Although this procedure of lumping together anonymous writings will seem undesirable from a scholarly point of view, it is absolutely essential for computer-assisted sorting and retrieval, and all contributors to Fontes are asked to follow it rigorously.

Note the following examples:

Various writings in Old English were used as sources by later writers, and abbreviations for these may be devised on the model of the following examples:

The Old English Martyrology = ANON.OEMart. [ed. G. Kotzor (Munich, 1981)]

The Old English Bede = ANON.OEBede. [ed. T. Miller, 4 vols. (London, 1891-8)]

The Anglo-Saxon Chronicle = ANON.ASChron. [ed. D. Dumville and S. Keynes (Cambridge, in progress): A (ed. J. Bately, 1986), B (ed. S. Taylor, 1983), etc.]

Such abbreviations as these are relatively straightforward. In the case of certain classes of anonymous writings, however, further specification in each abbreviation will be necessary. This is particularly the case with biblical commentaries where, for example, there may be dozens of anonymous commentaries on Matthew. A particular anonymous commentary may in such cases be specified by recourse to the present location of the manuscript in which it is preserved, or the name of its editor. Thus, for example, the anonymous (Hiberno-Latin) commentary preserved in Würzburg, Universitätsbibliothek M.p.th.f. 61 and edited by K. Köberlin could be abbreviated as: ANON.Comm.Matth.(Herbipol.) or ANON.Comm.Matth.(Köberlin).

One particularly large class of anonymous writings where contributors will inevitably have to devise their own abbreviations is hagiography. Abbreviations for saints' vitae, miracula and passiones should be modelled on the following examples:

Editions of saints' lives are specified in the Bollandists' Bibliotheca Hagiographica Latina, 2 vols. (Brussels, 1899-1901, with two suppl., 1911 and 1986) and in E. Dekkers, Clavis Patrum Latinorum (Steenbrugge, 1961), nos. 2049-2248. In the case of a saint's life that exists in several anonymous redactions which are designated by editors as vita prima, vita secunda, and so on, it is essential to incorporate such information in the abbreviation: for example, the Vita quarta S. Brigidae should be abbreviated as ANON.Vit.quart.Brigid.

Other sorts of anonymous writings may be classified under the following headings:

(a) Biblical apocrypha. The number of apocryphal texts in circulation in the British Isles during the early Middle Ages was very large, but it is not possible in the present state of our knowledge to give a complete list. Abbreviations should be modelled on the following examples:

Book of Enoch = ANON.Lib.Enoch
 Protevangelium of James = ANON.Proteuang.Iac.
 Gospel of Nicodemus = ANON.Act.Pilati
 Gospel according to the Hebrews = ANON.Euang.Hebr.
 Gospel of Thomas = ANON.Euang.Thom.
 Acts of Andrew = ANON.Act.Andr.
 Acts of Thomas = ANON.Act.Thom.

(b) Liturgical texts. It was the very nature of liturgical manuscripts to undergo adaptation and modification according to the requirements and practice of the local church for which the manuscript was written; the result is that, even though liturgical manuscripts may be broadly classified according to function, no two are exactly the same. Even the members of such broadly-defined classes as 'Gregorian Sacramentary' or 'Eighth-century Gelasian Sacramentary' share no more than a family resemblance. Accordingly, in cases where a liturgical book is cited as the source of an Anglo-Saxon text, it will be essential to specify fully the manuscript and edition from which the citation is taken. Only in cases where a manuscript or edition is cited frequently will it be appropriate to devise an ad hoc abbreviation.

(c) The promulgations of church councils (canon law). Latin versions of the canons of early church councils should be cited from the edition of C.H. Turner, Ecclesiae Occidentalis Monumenta Iuris Antiquissima, 2 vols. in 7 (Oxford, 1899-1939), and abbreviated in accordance with the following models:

Canones apostolorum = ANON.Can.apost.
 Council of Nicaea = ANON.Conc.Nic.
 Council of Antioch = ANON.Conc.Antioch.

Council of Sardica = ANON.Conc.Serdic. etc.

Canons of councils held in Africa should be cited according to the edition of C. Munier, CCSL 149 (Turnhout, 1974); those of Gaul according to that of C. Munier and C. de Clercq, 2 vols., CCSL 148-148A (Turnhout, 1963); in each case the place and year of the council should be specified: e.g. ANON.Conc.Gall.(Aurel.) 511. Collections of church councils should be cited and abbreviated as follows:

(f) Secular law-codes. It is not yet clear how many of the so-called barbarian law-codes were known in Anglo-Saxon England, but the following should be noted:

(g) Glossaries. As in the case of liturgical texts, it is evident that no two medieval glossaries are exactly the same, and that each successive copying of a glossary involved (to some extent at least) the process of redaction. It is essential, therefore, to specify fully the manuscript and edition of any medieval glossary which is cited; only if such a glossary is cited frequently will it be appropriate to devise an ad hoc abbreviation.

Note finally that a large number of anonymous works were transmitted pseudonymously in the Middle Ages. Where it is scholarly convention to identify such works by their pseudonym, the work should be specified as such. For example, the anonymous so-called Remedia peccatorum, which has been transmitted with the sermones of Augustine, should be abbreviated as ANON.Rem.pecc./PS.AVG.Serm.cccx.
