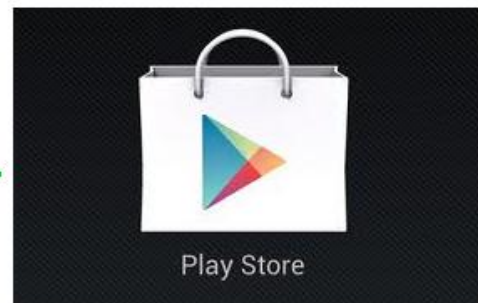

The Disability Assistance GUI is an android application. Android applications are distributed through the Google Play Store formerly known as the Android Market.

How to install an application on the Google Play Store:



First open the app drawer and open the Market or Google Play Store:



Search for our application in the Google Play Store and download the application.



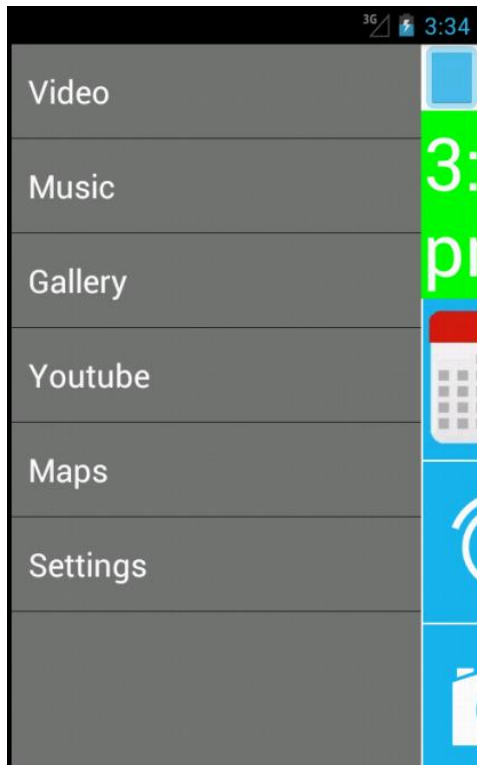
Disability Assistance GUI:

- Once installed, open the app drawer again and open the downloaded application. Once the application is open, your screen should look like this:



- This launcher is a simple interface with large buttons for easy access.
- These large buttons open up different applications already installed on the phone.
- To get back to the home screen from the launched application, press back one or more times.
- Applications on the home screen shown in the figure above include:
 - Dialer
 - Calendar
 - Email
 - Contacts
 - Alarm Clock
 - Internet Browser
 - Text
 - Camera
 - Facebook

- There is a slide-out menu button in the top left of the screen that provides another viewpoint for the user for more functionality.



- To get back to the home screen, either press the back button on the phone or touch the part of the screen that is not the slide out menu.
- This slide-out menu provides the user options to open more applications installed on the phone.
- The settings option launches the android phone's settings.
