5. Four clowns share 15 big red noses equally. How many noses are there per clown? How many noses are left over?

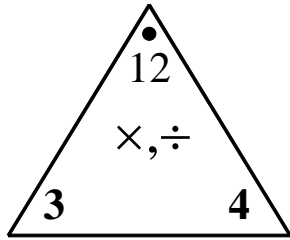
6. A grocery store sells bags of oranges. Each bag has 3 oranges. Mark buys 3 bags. How many oranges does he buy in all?

10. Write the fact family for the Fact Triangle.



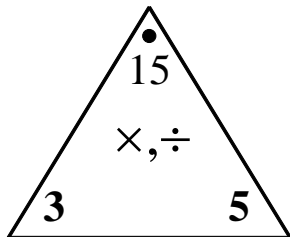
