Parts of Speech Mini-Project

You are becoming an expert of a part of speech! Congratulations! You are going to teach the class about one of the following parts of speech: **nouns, verbs, prepositions, adjectives, adverbs, pronouns, conjunctions, or interjections.**

1. You will work in a group of 3 on the part of speech: _____
2. This week you will be working on creating a lesson to teach the class about a part of speech that has been assigned to you. Your lesson plan must have the following items:
 - Learning Targets for your lesson
 - A visual teaching aid:
 - Including the part of speech, the definition, examples & explanations of varieties
 - A mini-lesson to teach the class about your part of speech
 - A student check for understanding
3. Your group of “teachers” will teach a 3-5 minute mini-lesson to the class.

My goal is for our class to have a great understanding of all parts of speech by the end of this school year and this is one way we will be working towards this goal.

Examples of Visual Aids:

You will choose to do one of these to assist you in teaching your lesson: PowerPoint, Comic Creator, Handout, Brochure, Flyer, Booklet, or a Poster for your part of speech to use to teach with. You and your group will create one of these as the visual aid to be a part of the lesson.

Examples of Mini-Lessons:

- PowerPoint
- Create a song, rap, poem
- Create a game
- Create Foldable
- Create a vocabulary card w/4 boxes (Must include part of speech, definition of your part of speech, examples, how it used in a sentence, picture or something else that fits your part of speech)
- Do a skit to teach your part of speech
- Demonstrate your brochure, handout, flyer, or booklet
- Use your created poster to teach lesson

Examples of Student Checks for Understanding:

- 5 Question Quiz
- Students sing song along with class and teacher
- Students learn the rap or poem and recite it as a class
- Students complete a worksheet
- Students play a game with the class and teacher
