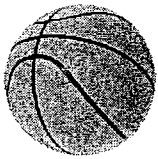

Which character do you like the most in your book? Why?

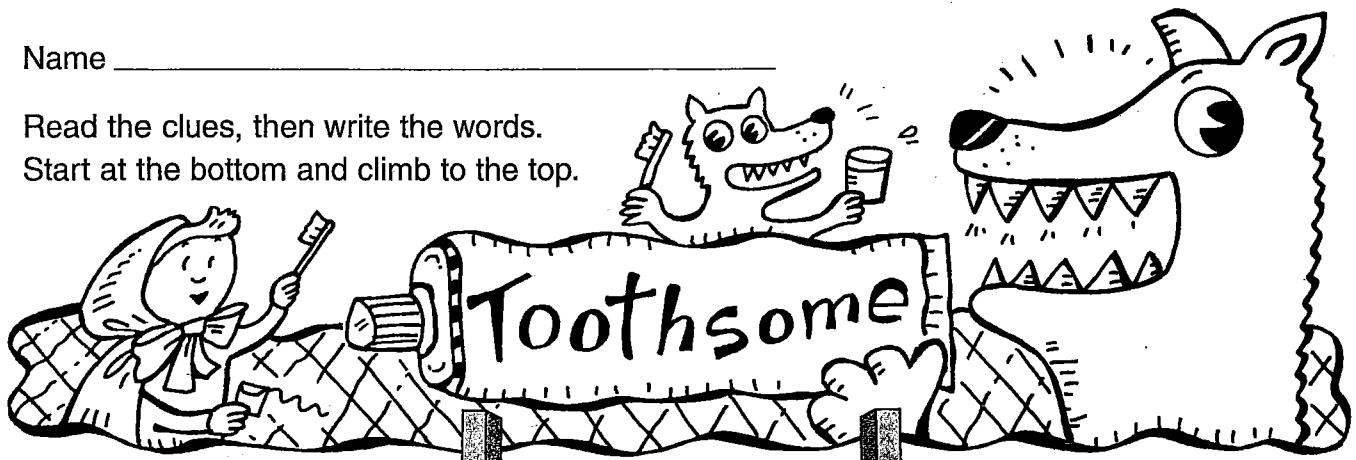
2. What do you predict will happen next in this story? What information in the text helped you make that prediction?
