

Inside/Outside Circles

Instructions:

- 1) Find a partner.
- 2) Decide who is A and who is B.
- 3) Form two circles, one inside the other.
A = Inside Circle
B = Outside Circle
- 4) Face your partner.
- 5) A: Write one important question with its answer.
(The teacher can also prepare these questions in advance.)
- 6) A: Ask B your question.
B: Answer A's question in 30 seconds or less.
A: Listen to B's answer and help if needed.
- 7) Outside Circle: When the bell dings, move left one space.
Inside Circle: Pass your question 2 people to the right.

[This gives inside circle members exposure to new questions.]
- 8) Inside Circle: When you reach your original partner, trade places with the outside circle.
