- Determine what career to pursue

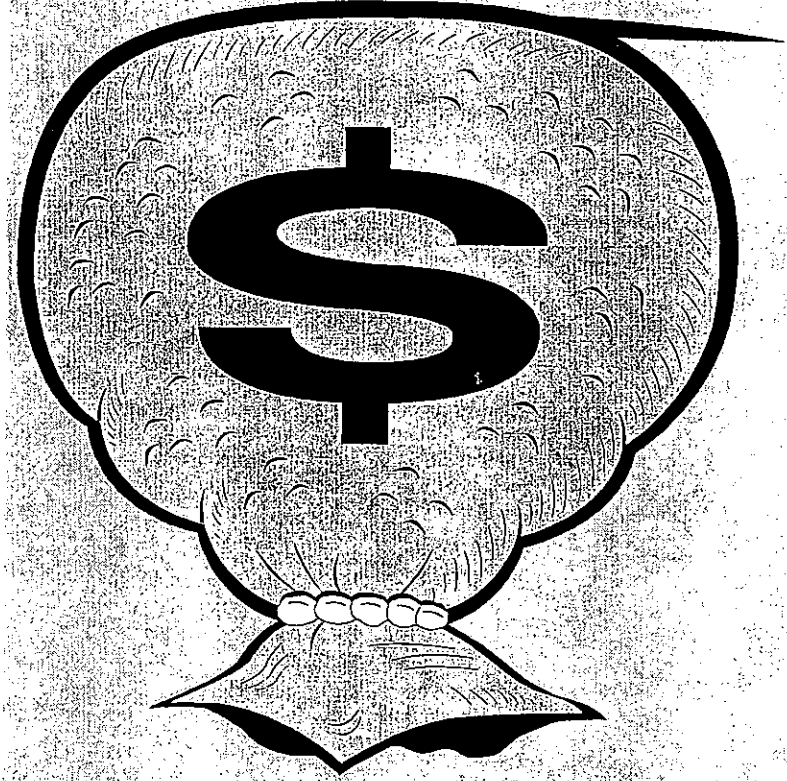
Earning Potential
