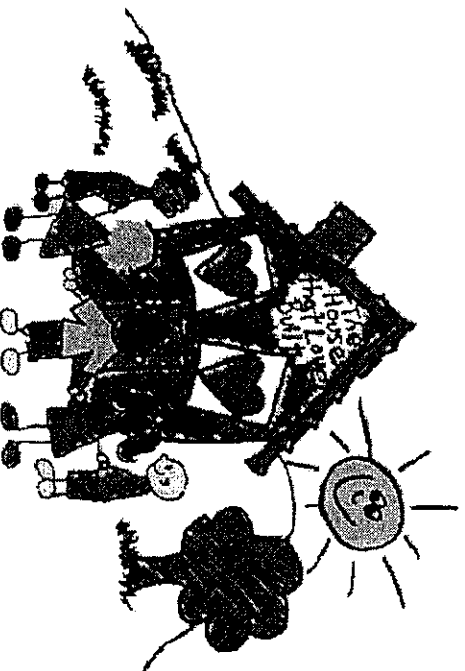

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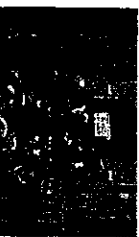

Belmont Hills Career Week

"Do you remember what you wanted to be when you were in third grade?" Belmont Hills third graders are posing that question to special guest speakers this week as they host a first-ever Career Week. A total of 27 presenters have come to speak with students about their career choices. Guests have included shop owners, lawyers, nurses, dentists, accountants, QVC buyers, philanthropists, custodians, athletic directors, coaches, a principal and even a superintendent. Career Week is the culminating project of a month-long exploration about the traits and skills that children possess and the types of jobs that may most enjoy. The lessons have been planned in conjunction with the school counselor as part of the new state counseling curriculum.
