

Researching the People of the Holocaust

The Assignment

1. Outline the people of the Holocaust. The four categories will be as follows:
 - a. Rescuers
 - b. Perpetrators
 - c. Victims
 - d. Bystanders
 - e. “Works Cited” (Roman Numeral V will be the place to list the web sites used for this lesson.
2. For each category you will give the following information:
 - a. Brief biography of a real person in that category
 - b. The role or function of this person in the Holocaust—perhaps actual words of this person which might express the person’s attitudes or point of view.
 - c. Picture of person if possible
3. Time line of the holocaust years –1933-1945
4. Write a two-paragraph response to the poem, “The Butterfly.”

The Tools

5. Use the Holocaust Web Sites document which is located in your teacher’s folder on the Resource drive.
6. You will use Microsoft Word to create your outline.

Creating your Document

7. Set all margins to one inch—**Format** menu, page setup
8. Insert a header and type in your heading—**View** menu, header and footer.
9. Exit header, type title in the center and press Enter twice
10. Begin the outline by choosing Numbering from the tool bar.
11. From the Format menu choose **Bullets and Numbering**
12. Select Roman Numerals for the first level.



Basic Outlining Principles

13. Press the TAB key to move to the right—down a level
14. Press SHIFT TAB to move to the left—up one level
15. Use the **Format menu/ Bullets and Numbering** to choose the style of the letter or number that you want.
